BE ITX REMEMBERED, That on the 5th day of April, 1901, ISAAC HOLLANDER was brought before me, J. S. BRADLEY, RECORDED OF THE TOWN OF HARRISONBURG, and as such acting as Mayor of said Town, in the absence of O. B. Roller, Mayor of said Town, and in such capacity, (ex officio justice of said County,) charged with a misdemeanor, (a warrant having been waived) in this, that he being, engaged in the mercantile business in the Town of Harrisonburg, did unlawfully solicit trade in person, by barking and catching at the same within the corporate limits of said town, other than at, or immediately in front of his place of business, or at the home of the person solicited, and is by me, upon the evidence off oath of Charles G. Campbell, and _____ Burgess, found guilty of said offence.

WHEREFORE I adjudged that he ~~xxxxxxx~~ be fined the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars. And the said Isaac Hollander having prayed an appeal from my said judgment, an appeal is hereby granted him to the next term of the County Court of Rockingham County, and the said judgment and conviction, as well as the said appeal are hereby certified to the said Court.
