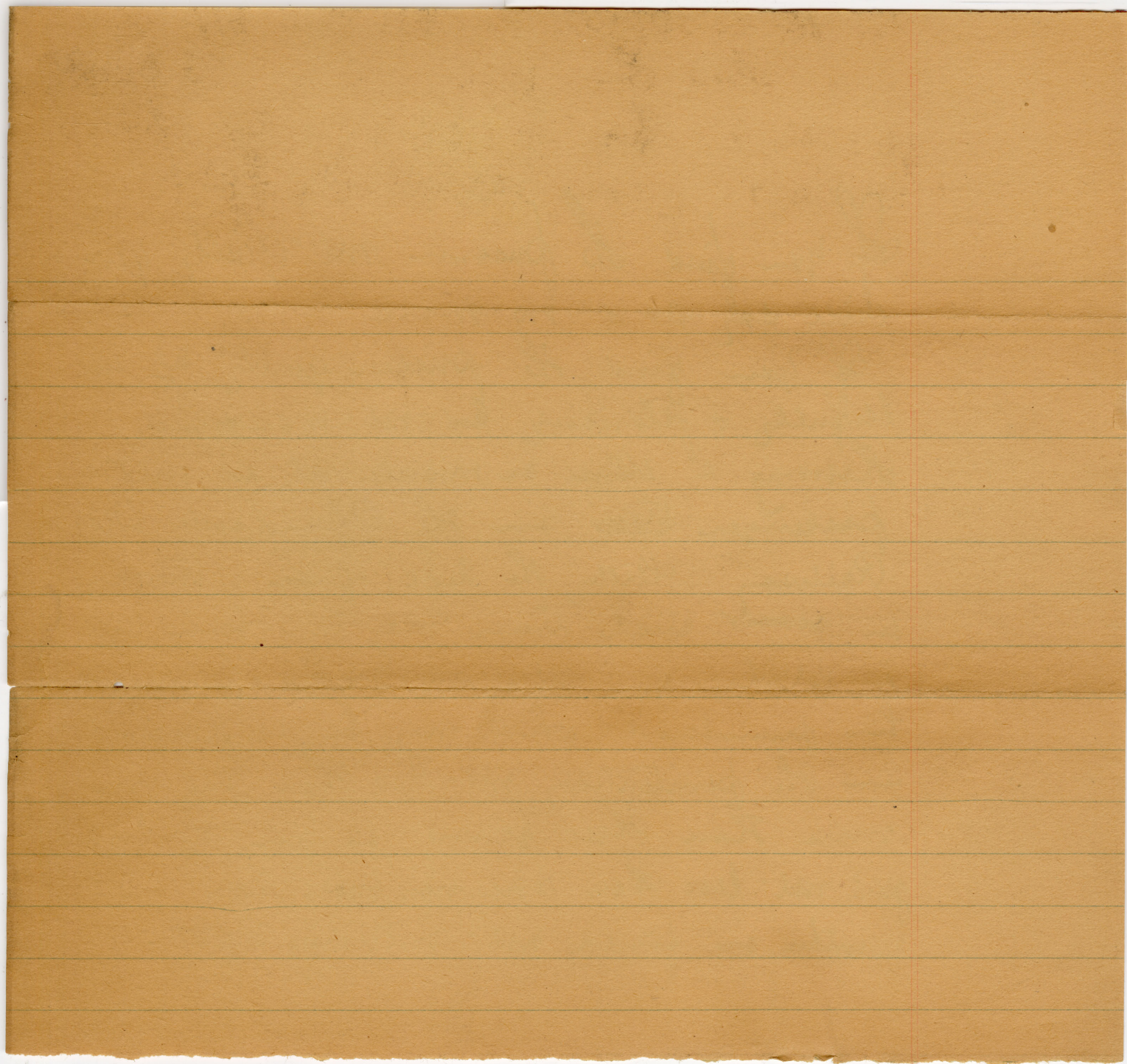

If you find the prisoner guilty of un-
lawfully + feloniously and-maliciously
throwing a stone or missile at-or into-a
passenger train on the Chesapeake Western
Railway whereby the life of ~~any~~ a traveler
in ~~such~~ such train may have been put-
in peril, you will say so + then ascertain
his punishment- which may be confinement-
in the penitentiary not-less than one nor
more than three years, or in the County
jail not-less than one nor more than twelve
months or fined not-exceeding \$500.
