Be it remembered that on the 26th day of July, 1902, Alice Driver was brought before me O.B. Roller, Mayor of the Town of Harrisonburg and Ex officio Justice of the said County, charged with a misdemeanor in this that she on the 22nd day of July, 1902, in said Town, as well as on divers, other days and times thereafter unlawfully did keep and maintain and does now keep and maintain a certain house of ill fame resorted to during all that time and now resorted to by divers, idle and disolute persons, both men and women for the purpose of prostitution and lewdness. And is by me upon the evidence of others, of Fannie Minor, Harriette Bradford, Mary Atkins, Emma Brown, Bettie Wells, Sam Spellman, William Thorpe, Minor Boyers, William Carrington, Lee wells, William Shrine, Geo. W. Brown and Virginus Clatterbuck found guilty of said offense before, I judge tat she pay a fine of \$25.00 and \$ 15.40 costs, and that she be confined in the jail of Rockingham County for the term of 30 days.

But the said Alice Driver having prayed and appeal for my said judgement, and tendered James Keister as her surety ~~who thereupon understood as her surety for the payment of~~ together with the said Alice Driver entered into recognizance in the penalty of \$200.00 conditional upon the appearance of the said Alice Driver ~~said judgement and all costs and damages in case the same be affirmed, an appeal is hereby granted her to the~~ said next term of the County Court of Rockingham County, and the said judgement and conviction as well as the said appeal are hereby certified to the said Court.
