Emmanuel Curry

} upon an Indictment for Felony.

This day came again the Attorney for the Commonwealth and the prisoner Emmanuel Curry was again led to the bar of the Court in Custody of the Jailor of this Court, and being thereof arraigned pleaded guilty to the said Indictment and waived trial by Jury and submitted all matters of law and fact for trial to the Court the Attorney for the Commonwealth being present and consenting thereto and the Court having heard the evidence and argument of Counsel doth adjudge the said Emmanuel Curry guilty in manner and form as charged in the Indictment. And it appearing to the Court that the said Prisoner Emmanuel Curry is under the age of fifteen years of age and a fit subject for Commitment to the Custody of the Negro Reformatory Association of Virginia in Hanover County Virginia, and the Superintendent of said Association having consented to this Commitment. It is ordered that the said Emmanuel be forthwith conveyed and delivered into the Custody of the Superintendent of the Negro Reformatory Association of Virginia in Hanover County Va. there to be kept and treated in the manner prescribed by law for the term of three years. And thereupon the prisoner was remanded to Jail.
