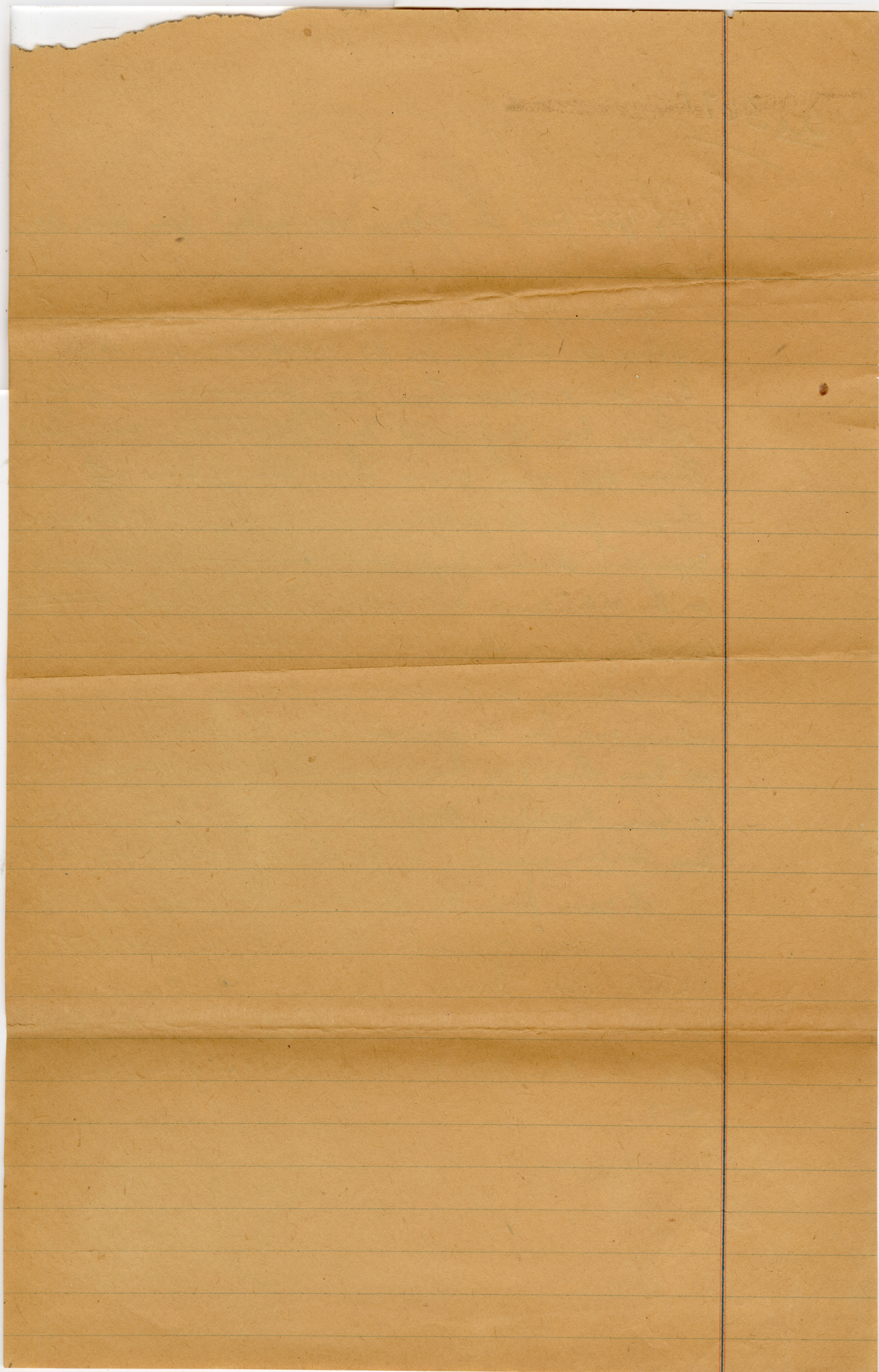

If you find the prisoner not-guilty you will say so + no more -

If you find the prisoner guilty - in manner & form as charged in the indictment - you will say so + ascertain his punishment - which shall be confinement in the penitentiary not-less than one nor more than ten years, &

If you find the prisoner not-guilty of maliciously assaulting James Lloyd with intent to murther as charged in the indictment - but-guilty of unlawfully ~~assaulting~~ ~~assaulting~~ said Lloyd with the intent aforesaid you will say so + ascertain his punishment - which may be confinement in the penitentiary not-less than one nor more than five years or in your discretion confinement in jail not-exceeding twelve months + fine not-exceeding \$500.

If you find the prisoner not-guilty of either of the felonies aforesaid but-guilty of assault & battery upon James Lloyd you will say so + ascertain his punishment - which may be fine of not-less than \$500 or confinement in jail, or both -
