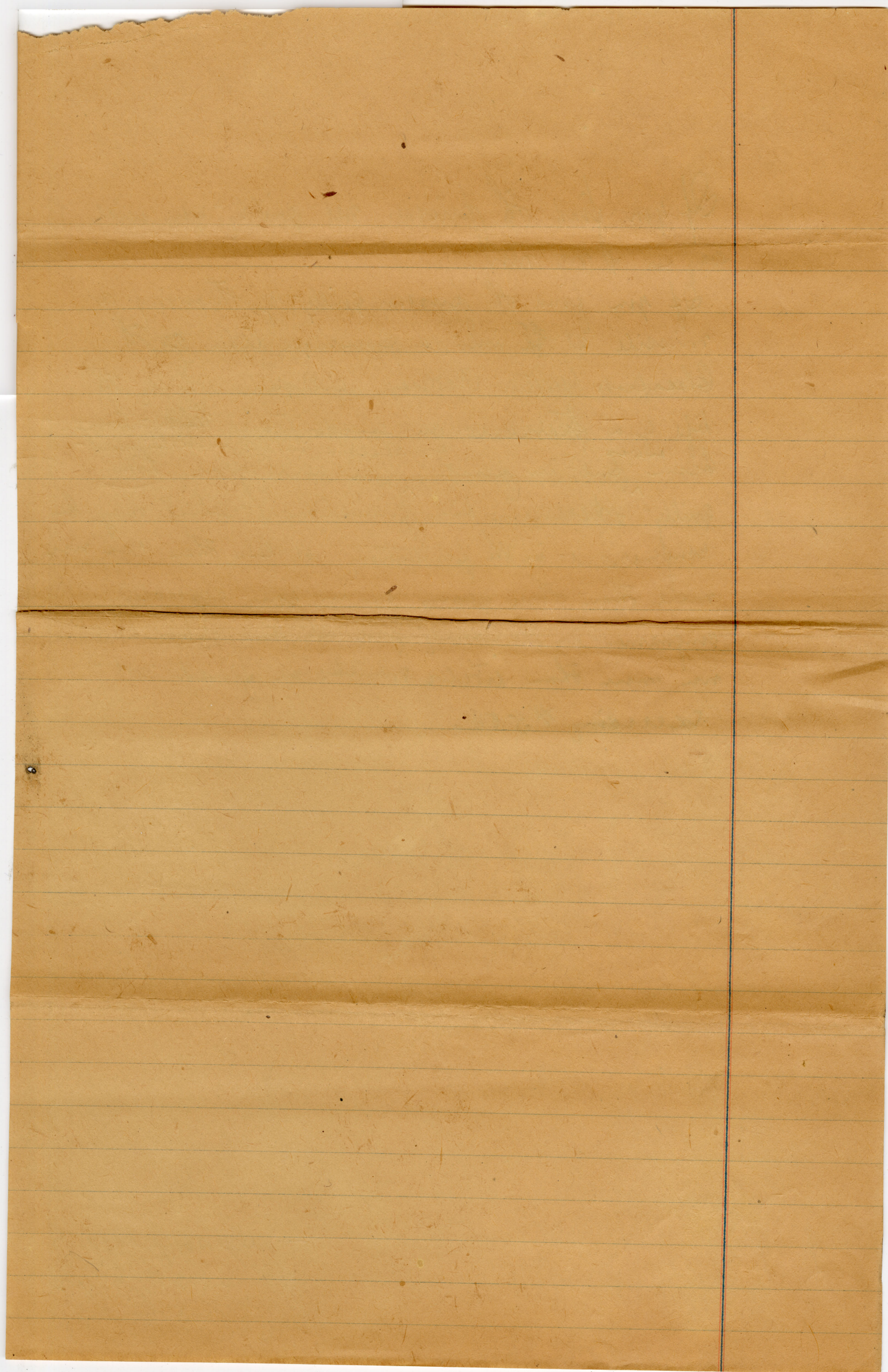
We the Jury find the prisoner guilty, and ascertain his punishment at Confinement in the County Jail for six months.
