William Spitzer alias C. P. Crow

on the 13th day of May, in the year 1903, in the said County,

did feloniously forge a certain order for the payment of money, commonly called a check, purporting to be the order or draft of William Crow upon the Rockingham National Bank of Harrisonburg, Virginia for the payment of Twenty five Dollars ^{to C. P. Crow or bearer} with intent thereby to defraud William L. Crow and to the prejudice of the rights of said William L. Crow & others against the peace & dignity of the Commonwealth.

And the grand jurors aforesaid upon their oaths aforesaid do further present that William Spitzer alias C. P. Crow on the 13th day of May in the year 1903, in the said County did feloniously forge a certain order for the payment of money, commonly called a check, purporting to be the order or draft of William Crow upon the Rockingham National Bank of Harrisonburg, Virginia, for the payment of Twenty five Dollars to C. P. Crow or bearer with intent thereby to defraud & to the prejudice of the rights of others, the said William Spitzer alias C. P. Crow at the time of the commission of said forgery representing & declaring that the signature to said check was intended as for the signature of William L. Crow against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Crow, to the Jail of said County, that he may be tried before the County Court of said County for a felony by him committed, in this, that he, on the 13th day of May, 1903, in said town, in said County, did felonously forge a certain order for the payment ^{of} ~~for~~ money, commonly called a check, purporting to be the order, of draft, of one William Crow on the Rockingham National Bank, for the payment of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)


