

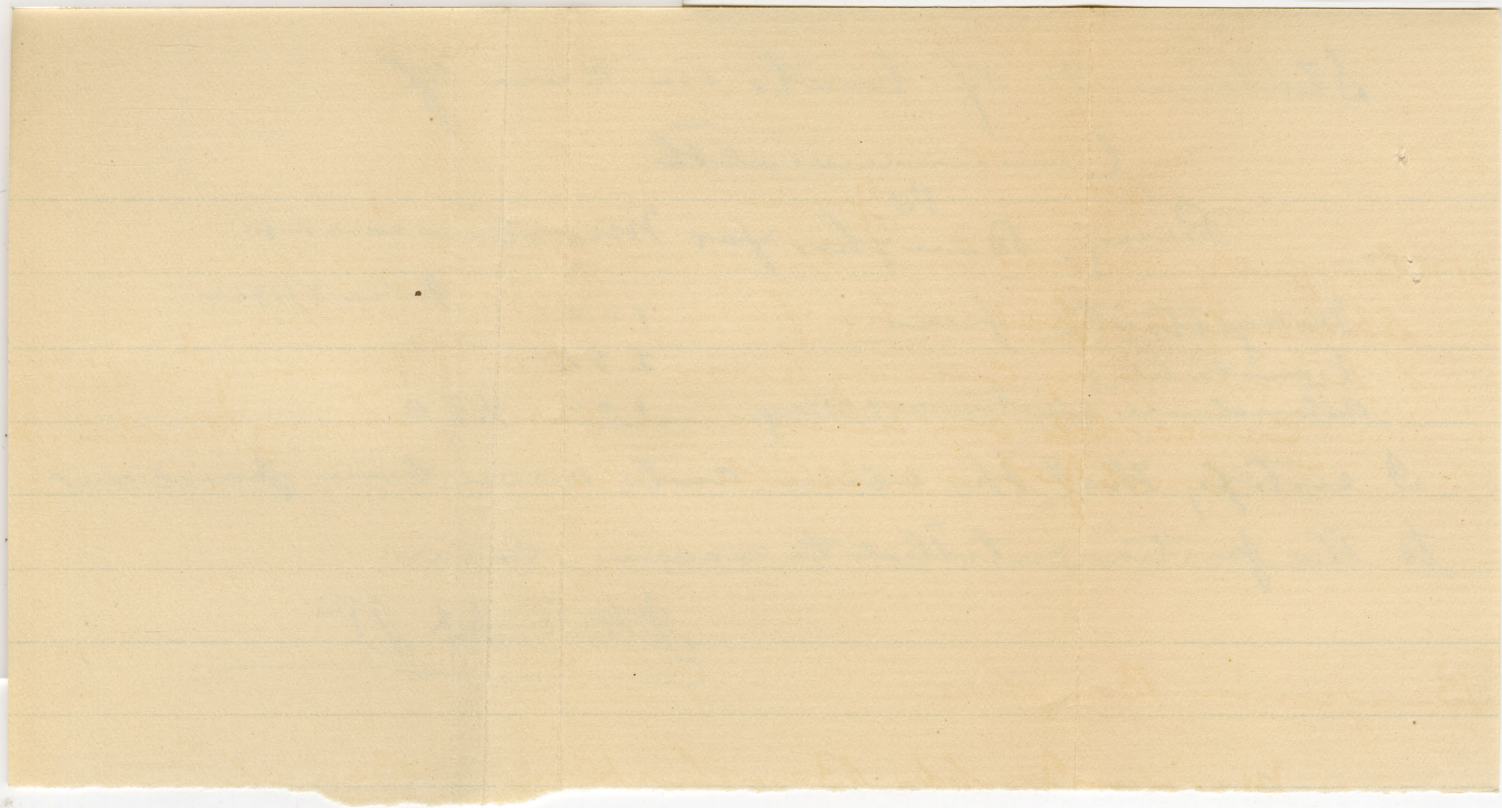

WHEREAS, John E. Williams

complaint and information on oath before me,

J. S. Shipp

a Justice of the said county, that

Benjamin Bangher

of the said county, on the

unlawfully assault him the said John E. Williams
by striking his fist in his face and threatening to
beat him and by cursing him and drawing a Pistol
before concealed on him and threatening to shoot
him the said John E. Williams

These are therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to command you forthwith to apprehend
and bring before me, or some other Justice of the said County, the body of the said

to answer the said complaint, and to be farther dealt with according to law. And you are required to summon

Wm. H. Maiden Joseph Bangher Dave Bangher

John Collier and Frank Dean George Shipp

to appear and give evidence in behalf of the Commonwealth, on the examination touching the said offence.

Baugher found not guilty of carrying concealed weapons but guilty of unlawful assault and adjudge to pay a fine of \$100.00 for the use of the Commonwealth and 4.00 cost which was paid and Defendant discharged from custody.
