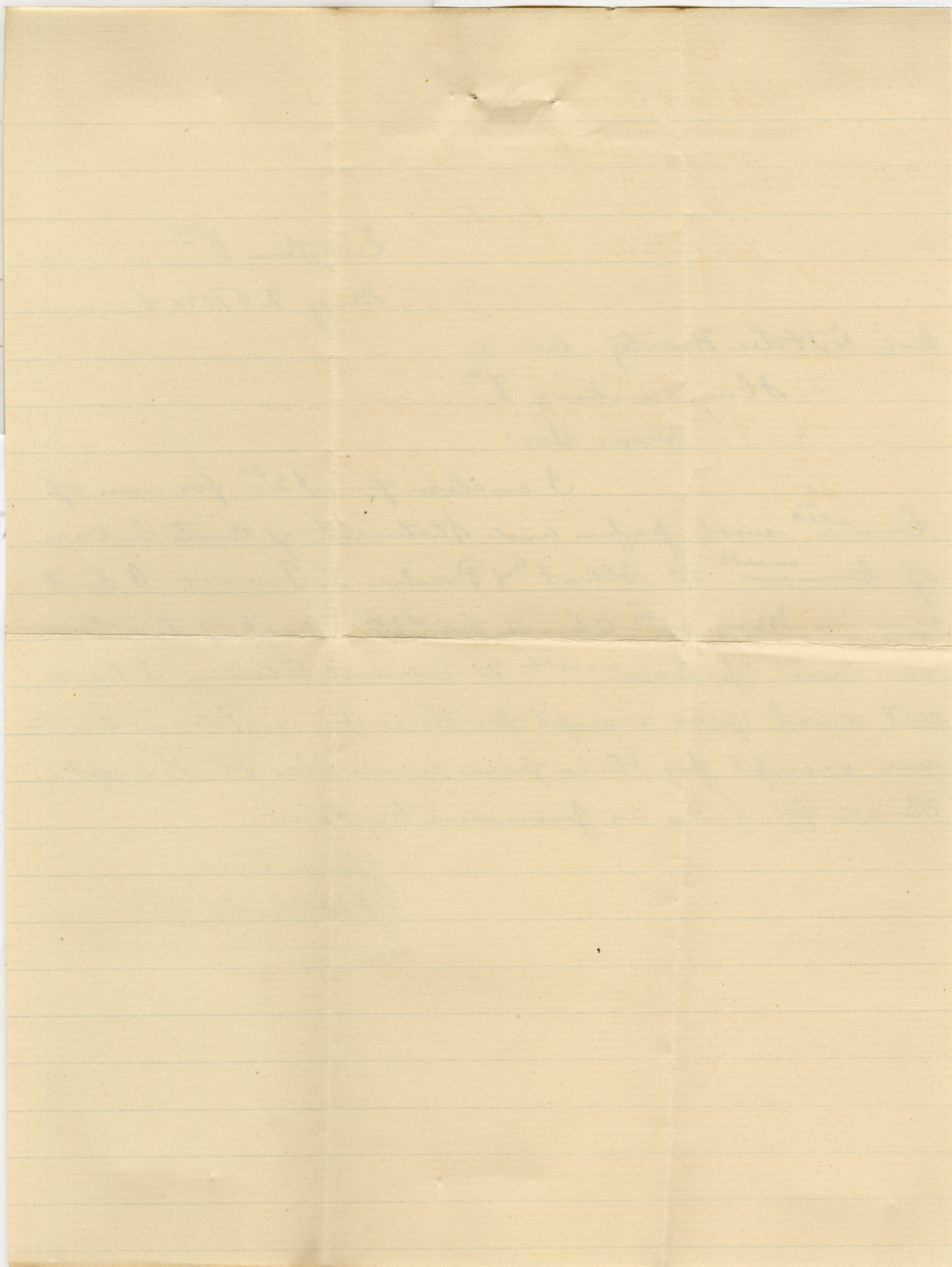

WHEREAS, Thomas Dofelmayer of the said county, has this day made complaint and information on oath before me, J. H. Shipp a Justice of the said county, that

of the said county, on the 16th day of May 1904, in the said county, did willfully ^{and} unlawfully cut, and carry away a quantity of wood and timber belonging to and the property of J. W. Dofelmayer & Sons and of timber so carried away being estimated to be about five cords

These are therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me, or some other Justice of the said County, the body of the said

Albert Turner and Preston L. Turner
to answer the said complaint, and to be farther dealt with according to law. And you are required to summon Russell Dofelmayer Milton Dofelmayer Frank Dofelmayer
Mrs. Milton Dofelmayer

to appear and give evidence in behalf of the Commonwealth, on the examination touching the said offence.
