deliver into the Custody of the Keeper of the
sd Jail the body of John Hubbard late of
sd County charged before me with having or
or about the 10th day of Nov^r last past, at
the County aforesaid, forged & counterfeited
a certain piece of writing purporting to be
a certificate of Registry of a free man of
color — and you the sd Jailor is hereby required
to receive the sd John Hubbard into your Jail
and Custody, and him there safely to keep
until he shall there be discharged by
due course of Law Given under my hand
& Seal this 21st day of Decem^r in the
year 1832)

Be it remembered that on the 21 day of December
in the year 1832 Wm West of S^d County farmer
personally came before me Geo. Clarke Justice
of the peace for the County aforesaid, & acknowledged
said himself to owe to John Floyd governor
of the Commonwealth of Virginia & his succes-
sors - one hundred Dollars lawful money of this
Commonwealth to be made & levied of his goods
& Chattels Land & Tenements to the use of the
S^d Commonwealth if the S^d Wm West shall
fail in the conditions underwritten

The condition of the above written Re-
cognizance is such, that if the above bound
Wm West, shall have his Slave Benjamin,
to appear at the Court house, of S^d County
on Thursday the 27 day of December, ear-
ly in the forenoon for the Commonwealth aforesaid, against
John Hubbard, charged with counterfeiting
& forgery - Then the S^d Recognizance to be
void or else to remain in its force,

Whereas John Hubbard a free man of color laborer, hath this day been committed to the Jail of said County of Rockingham by my warrant, for having on or about the 10th day of November last past, in the County aforesaid, feloniously, forged and counterfeited, a certain writing, as also the Seal of the County of Shenandoah, which is attached to said writing, with intent to injure Mr West of the County of Rockingham, the tenor of which forged writing is as follows — "Virginia to wit

Register No 95 Be it remembered that Arch Allen a free Man of Color, and who was emancipated by Robt Carter, about thirty two years of age, about five feet six inches high, of a very dark complexion, has a small scar on his right cheek bone, and a very small scar in his forehead Registered this 14 day of August 1821

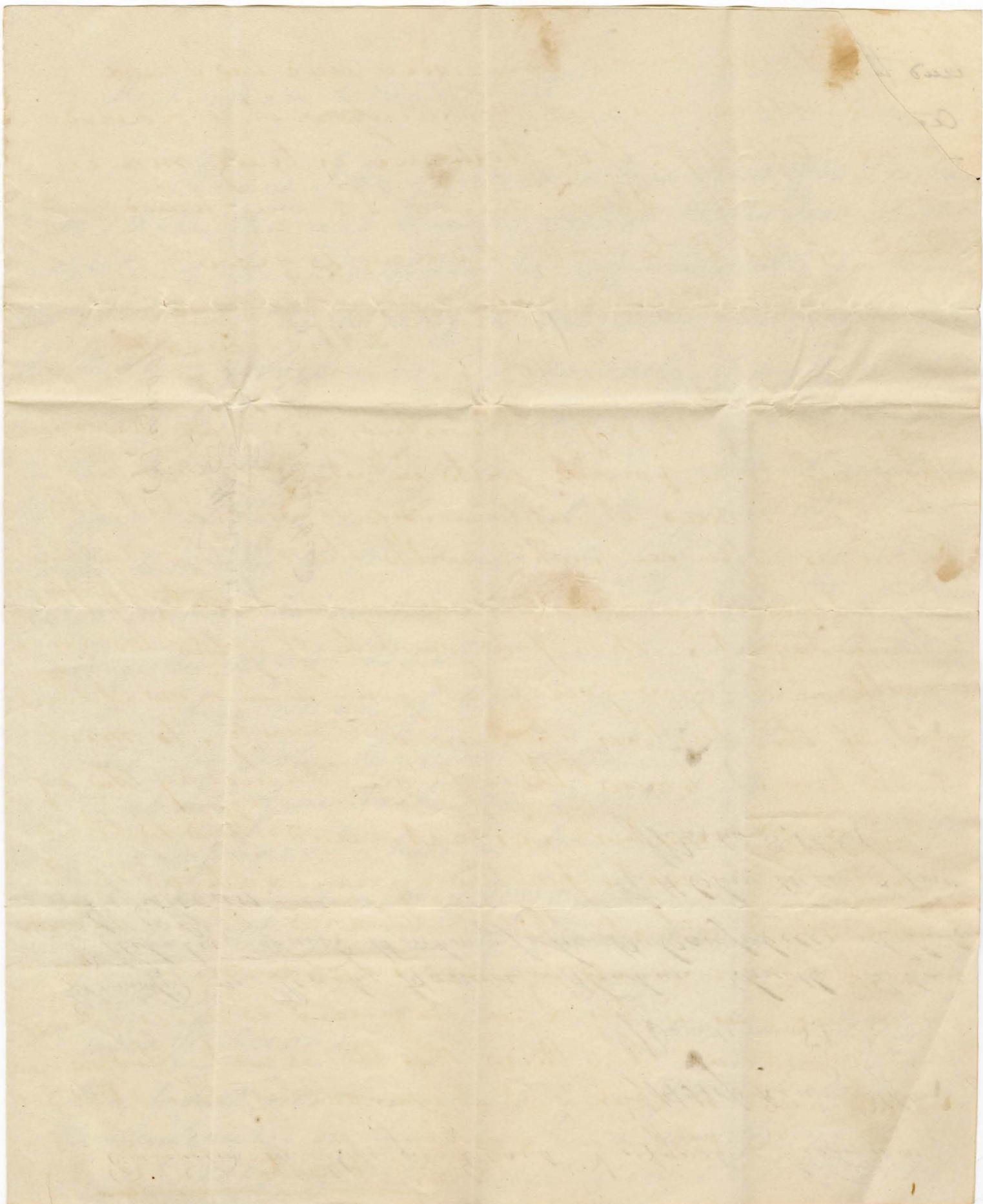
At a Court continued and held for the County of Shenandoah, on Tuesday the 14 day of August 1821 Register No 95 of Arch Allen produced to the Court

and the same being examined and the said
Archer Allen inspected, thereupon it is ordered
to us certify, that the same is truly correct
in hereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal of the D^y County the day & year

L. Williams C.S.C

and for altering the D^y forged writing, and Seal, knowing
the same to be forged, with intent to injure the D^y
Wm West, and it appearing to me, that the
felonious offence, where with the D^y John Hubbard
stands charged, ought to be examined into by the
County Court, therefore on behalf of the Common
wealth I require you that you summon at least
Eight of the Justices of your D^y County, to meet
at the Court house thereof on Thursday the 27
day, of December instant, and there & there
to hold a Court, for the examination of the
fact, with which the D^y John Hubbard stands
charged, & for such purposes concerning the
premises, as is by Law required & directed and
that you have thus these this Warrant Given
as my hand & Seal, at Hammonburg this 21 day
of December 1832

Whereas William West of said County hath this day made oath before me Geo Clarke a Justice of the peace for the County aforesaid that he hath good cause to suspect, and doth suspect that John Hubbard a free man of color did feloniously, forge & counterfeit a certain piece of writing, purporting to be a Certificate of Registry of a free man of color. There are therefore to command you, the Jailer of said County, to bring the sd John Hubbard before me, forthwith to answer the premises & further to be dealt with according to Law Given under my hand & Seal this 21 Decr 1832
