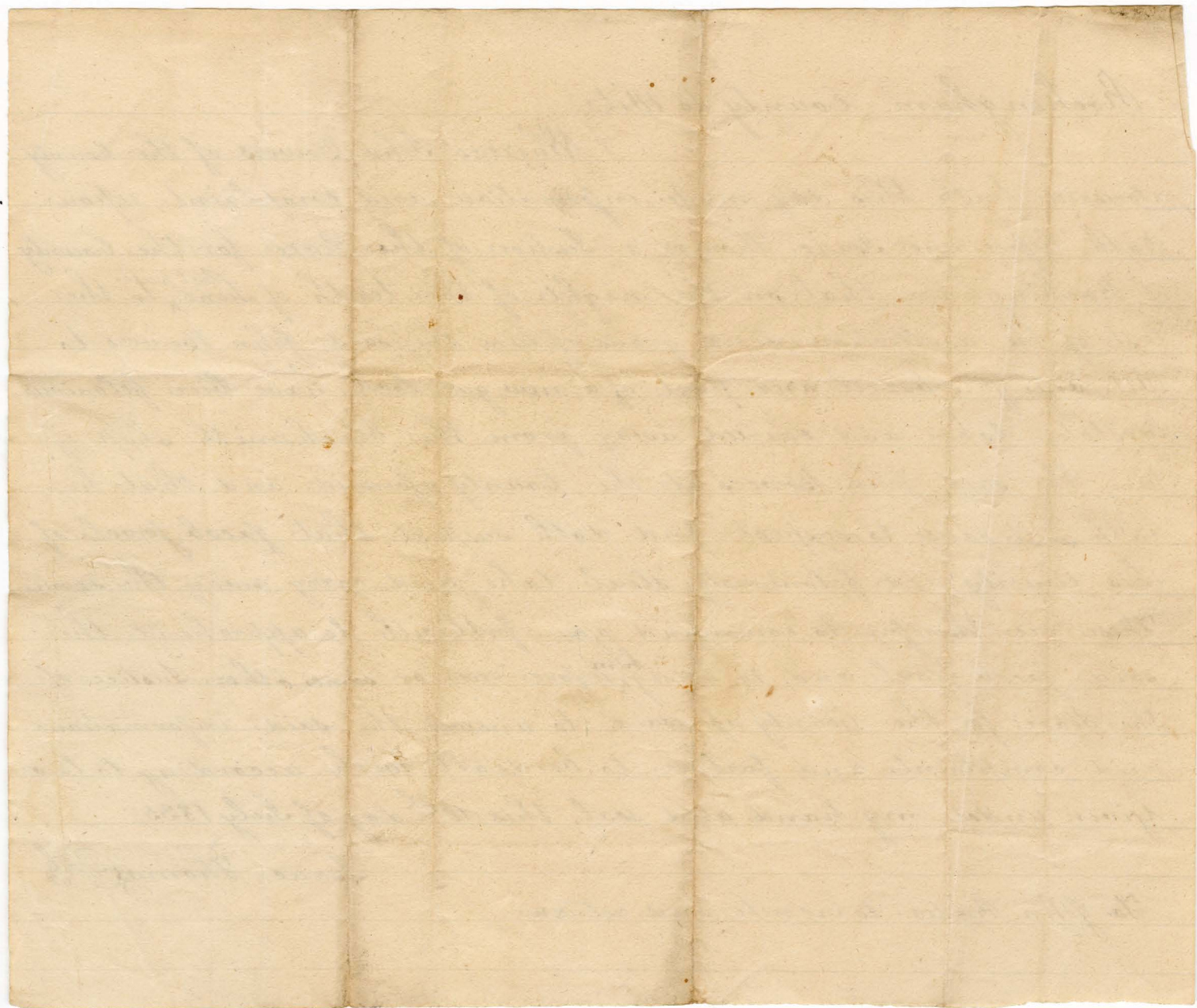


Rockingham County to wit

Whereas John Bowers of the County  
aforesaid hath this day made information and complaint upon  
Oath before me Isaac Thomas a Justice of the Peace for the County  
of Rockingham, that on the night of the tenth of June<sup>last past</sup> to the  
best of his recollection, divers goods of him the said John Bowers to  
wit, one gun barrel and part of a new gun lock, have been felonious-  
ly stolen taken and carried away from the blacksmith shop of  
him the said John Bowers at the County aforesaid and that he  
hath just cause to suspect and doth suspect that Jacob Jewel of  
this County did feloniously, steal take and carry away the same  
These are therefore to command you forthwith to apprehend the  
said Jacob Jewel and to bring<sup>him</sup> before me or some other Justice of  
the Peace for the County aforesaid to answer the said information  
and complaint and further to be dealt with according to law  
Given under my hand and seal this 10<sup>th</sup> day of July 1835

where as Jacob Sweet of the County of Rockingham  
laborer was this day committed to the Jail of this County  
by my warrant for <sup>feloniously taking & carrying away</sup> stealing <sup>the property of John Daniels of great value to wit of the value of \$5.00</sup> one Gun barrel & part of a gun  
lock, & it appearing to me that the felonious offence where with  
he stands charged ought to be examined into by the County Court  
therefore on behalf of the Commonwealth I require you that you  
summons at least Eight of the Justices of your said County to  
meet at the Court house on the 18 day of July 1835 and then  
and there to hold a court for the examination of the facts <sup>with</sup> of  
which the said Jacob Sweet stands charged and for such  
other purposes concerning the premises as is by Law required  
and directed and that you have them and then this warrant  
at Given under my hand and seal this 10 day of  
July 1835



Memorandum that upon this 10<sup>th</sup> day  
of July in the year 1835 John Bowers & Martin ~~Herst~~ <sup>Herst</sup> of the  
County of Rockingham came before me Charles C. Spears a  
Justice of the peace for the County aforesaid and each  
of them, of his proper person acknowledged himself  
indebted to Settlement to Laquell Esqr Governor or Chief  
Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia and his succes-  
sors in the sum of one hundred Dollars to be lying security  
of each of their goods & chattels, lands & tenements respectively  
to the use of said Commonwealth of conditions that if  
each of them do personally appear before the Common-  
wealth Justices of the peace for the said County of Rock-  
ingham on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of July 1835 at a court by them  
to be held at the Court house of the said County for the exami-  
nation of Jacob Savet and as then and there or be half of the  
said Commonwealth, give such evidence as they knoweth against  
the said Jacob Savet concerning the matter whereunto he is  
charged and that neither of them do depart without  
leave of the said court then this recognizance to be void  
else to remain in full force as

said County - Where as Jacob Jewell late of  
of the County of Rockingham labourer hath been arre-  
sted for suspicion of a felony by him as it is said  
committed in stealing a gun barrel ~~and~~ part of  
gun lock of the value of Five Dollars the property of  
John Towns of the County of Rockingham. Therefore on  
behalf of the <sup>said</sup> Commonwealth I command you that you receive  
the said Jacob Jewell into your custody in the said Jail  
that he remain till he be delivered from your custody by  
any course of Law Given under my hand and seal this 10<sup>th</sup> day  
of the said County the 10 day July in the year of our long  
one thousand ~~eight~~ <sup>eight</sup> hundred and thirty five and in the  
60<sup>th</sup> year of the Commonwealth
