You are therefore hereby required to bring the said Elizabeth Seitzel before me or some other justice of the peace for this county to be associated with two other justices of the said county on the 22nd day of February next, at the house of the said Elizabeth Seitzel in this county to be examined concerning her state of mind and the causes of her insanity according to the act of Assembly in that case made and provided. You are furthermore required to give notice of this warrant to at least two other justices of the peace for the said county and to request their attendance at the time and place aforesaid; and then and there make due return of this warrant.
