and carry away. And One pair of pants of the value of \$1.00, one razor of the value of \$1.00, one vest of the value of \$1.00 one shirt of the value of \$1.00

of the goods and chattels of the said Peter Engan in the said ~~outhouse~~ ^{dwellin^ghouse}, then and there being found, then and there ~~feloniously~~ ^{and burglariously} did steal, take and carry away, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia. And the Jurors aforesaid, upon their oath aforesaid, do further present, that James Arington

The jury find the prisoner James Arington
not guilty of any of the charges charged
in the indictment but guilty of Petit Larceny
in manner and form as charged in the indictment
and ascertain the term of his imprisonment in
the County Jail at sixty days.

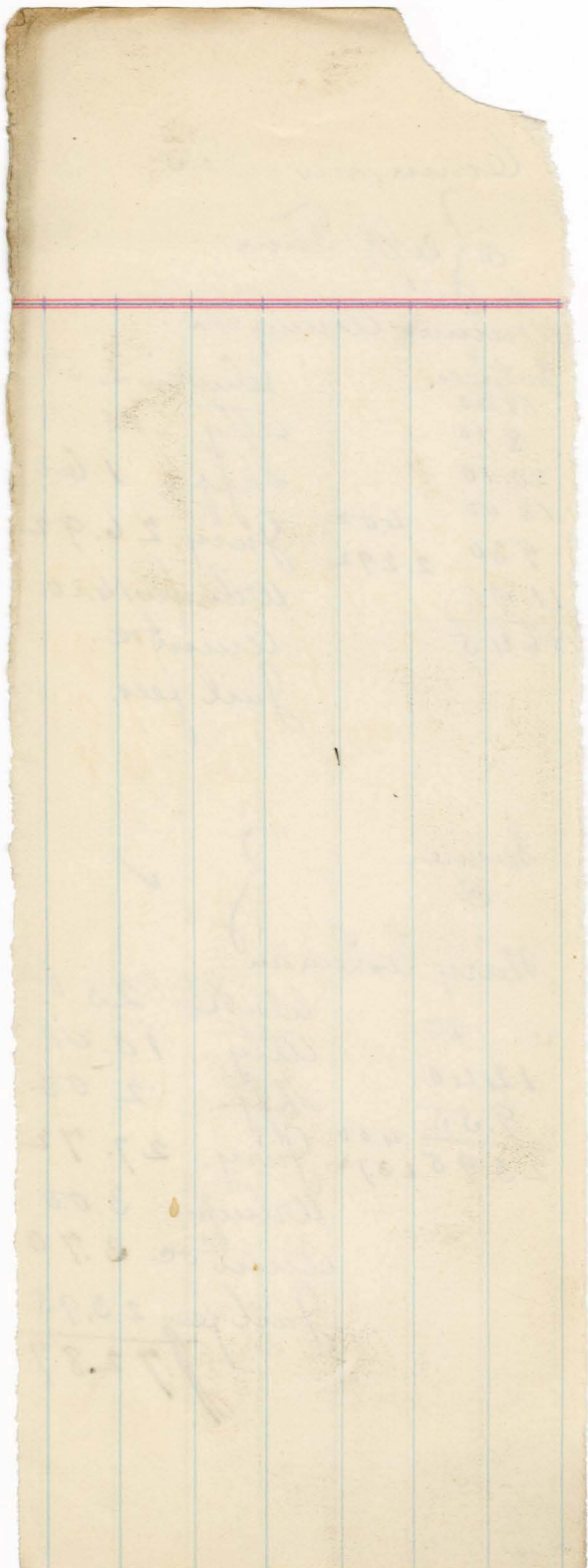

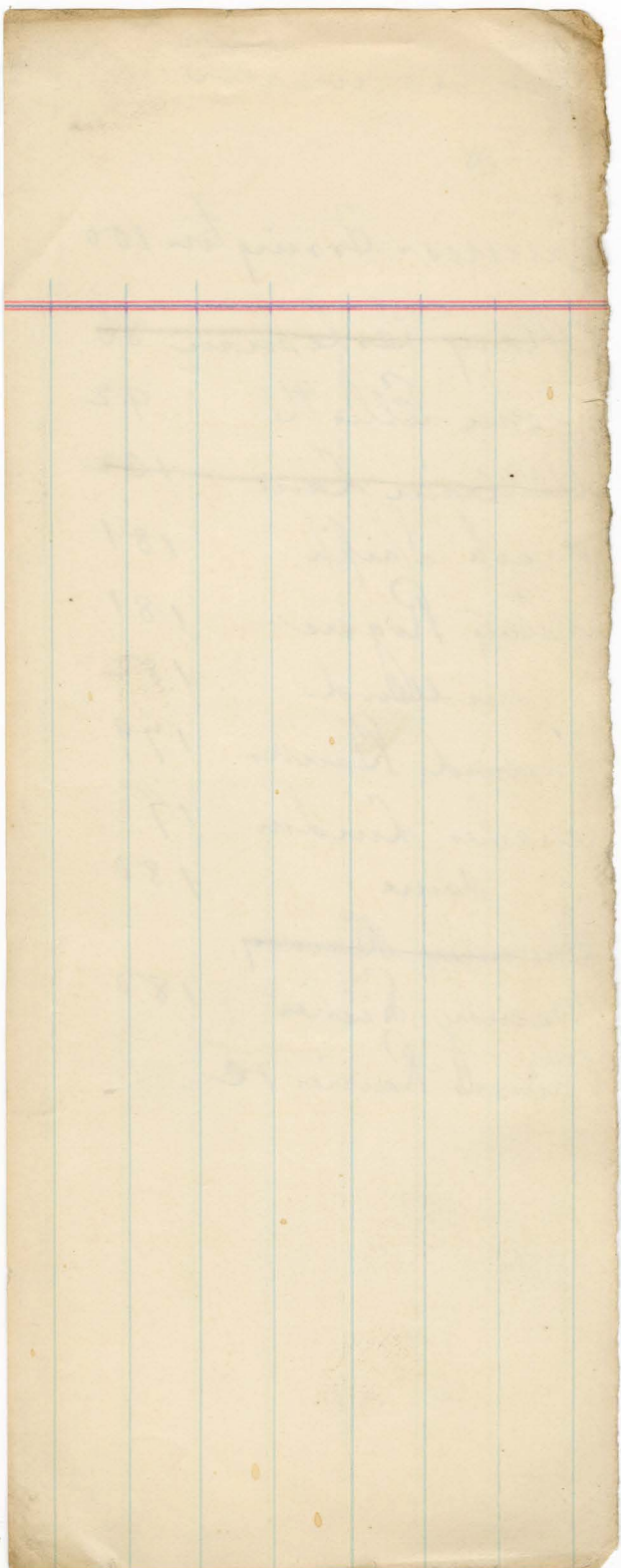
