


Virginia Rockingham County to wit.

Take and Carry away therefrom three
bushels of Corn of the value of fifty cents
per bushel.

To John Long Special Constable to execute this Warrant.

Whereas John Long of the said County has this day made complaint and information on oath before me A. C. Rohr a Justice of the said County that Charles London and Mammy Fisher both of said County on the 15th day of February 1890 in the night time of that day in said County did feloniously and ~~gloriou~~^{callid a corn crib} break and enter certain out House belonging to James Kavenough in which were stored away Corn and did steal same and carry away therefrom four bushels of Corn belonging to said James Kavenough of the value of fifty cents per bushel. There are therefore to command you in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia forthwith to apprehend and bring before one or some other Justice of the said County the busters of the said Charles London and Fisher to answer the said complaint and to be further dealt with according to law.


