one hundred and fifty Dollars (\$150⁰⁰), of the
goods and chattels of Daniel Long feloniously
did steal take and carry away.

There are therefore to command you in the name
of the Commonwealth of Virginia forthwith
to apprehend the said Henry Rogers and bring
him before me or some other Justice of the
said County to answer the said complaint and
to be further dealt with according to law.
