Whereas John Werner has this day made com-
plaint and information on oath before me A.
C. Rohr a Justice of said County that E. A.
Shands on the 23rd day of May 1891 in said
County did ^{unlawfully} assault him by forcibly taking a
cane from him and otherwise abusing him
and further says upon oath that he threatened
to beat him the first time he caught him in
town and alone - and in consequence of such
treatment and threats he is afraid he will
do him some serious bodily injury - and asks
that he the said E. A. Shands be required to
give bond to keep the peace toward him.
There are therefore to require you in the name
of the commonwealth of Virginia forthwith to
apprehend the said E. A. Shands and bring
him before me or some other Justice of the said
County to answer the said complaint and to be
further dealt with according to law.
