This Indictment is found on the testimony of Ashby
Malaise, W^m Fultz & Geo W Willis witnesses sworn
in Court and sent before the Grand Jury to give
evidence -

We the Jury find the defendant
Annie Gay guilty of keeping a house
of ill fame awarded to for the purpose
of prostitution & condones the manner &
from as charged in the indictment
and ascertain the term of her confinement
in the County Jail at thirty days and
assess her fine at five dollars
