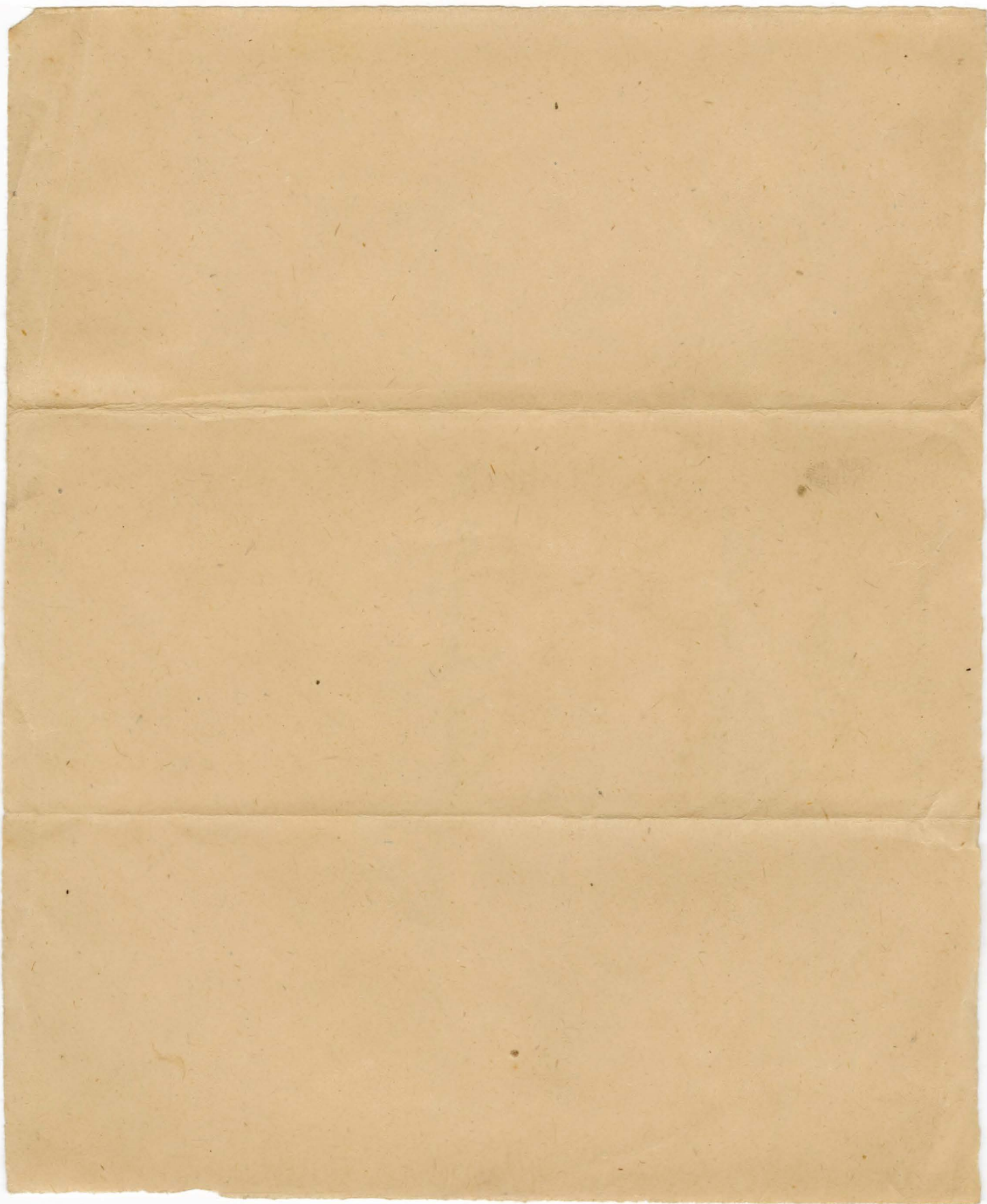

The Jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in and for the body of the County of Rockingham and now attending the said Court, Upon their oath present, that Peyton Goodloe on the 24th day of December in the year 1892 in the said County one overcoat of the value of six dollars of the goods and chattels of one John Wesley Miller, him and him being found, feloniously did steal take and carry away against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia -

This indictment is found on the testimony of John Wesley Miller, Geo. W. Willis, W. S. Sullivan witnesses sworn in Court and sent before the Grand Jury to give evidence -

We the jury find the defendant Payson
Goodloe guilty of Petit Larceny in manner
and form as charged in the indictment and
ascertain the quantum of his fine at seven
dollars and fifty Cents.
