B.} ~~A. D.~~ Downs did wilfully, unlawfully, maliciously and feloniously make an assault; and then and there, with a knife in his hand had and held, him the said ^{C. B.} ~~A. D.~~ Downs did wilfully, unlawfully, maliciously, and feloniously strike, cut, wound, and stab; with intent then & there him the said ^{C. B.} ~~A. D.~~ Downs to wilfully, unlawfully, maliciously and feloniously maim, disfigure, disable and kill, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia - This indictment is found on the testimony of ^{C. B.} ~~A. D.~~ Downs, Paul Hitt, Joseph N. Manzy, J. L. Burner, and M. M. Jarmine witnesses sworn in Court and sent before the Grand Jury to give evidence -

• We the jury find the prisoner Jim Young not guilty of Maliciously but guilty of unlawfully striking Cutting wounding and stabbing W. P. Downs with intent to maim disfigure disable and kill in manner and form as charged in the Indictment, and ascertain the term of his Confinement in the penitentiary at One year
