And one guilt of the value of five dollars

of the goods and chattles of the said Linn Taylor in the said dwelling house, then and there being found, then and there feloniously did steal, take and carry away, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia. And the Jurors aforesaid, upon their oath aforesaid, do further present, that David Candan on the 6th day of February, in the year 1895, in the said County, a certain outhouse, called a dwelling house, the property of one Linn Taylor not adjoining to or occupied with the dwelling-house of the said there situated, in the day time of that day feloniously did break and enter, with intent the goods and chattels of the said Linn Taylor in the said dwelling house then and there being, feloniously to steal, take and carry away. And one guilt of the value of five dollars

of the goods and chattels of the said Linn Taylor in the said dwelling house, then and there being found, then and there feloniously did steal, take and carry away, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia. of the goods and chattels of the said Linn Taylor in the said dwelling house then and there being found, then and there feloniously did steal, take and carry away, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of Linn Taylor, D. D. Moyers & Wm H. Hultz witness sworn in Court and sent before the Grand Jury to give evidence.

We the jury find the prisoner David Candan, not guilty of Burglary as charged in the indictment, but find him guilty of housebreaking in manner and form as charged in the indictment and ascertain the term of his Confinement in the Penitentiary at two years.

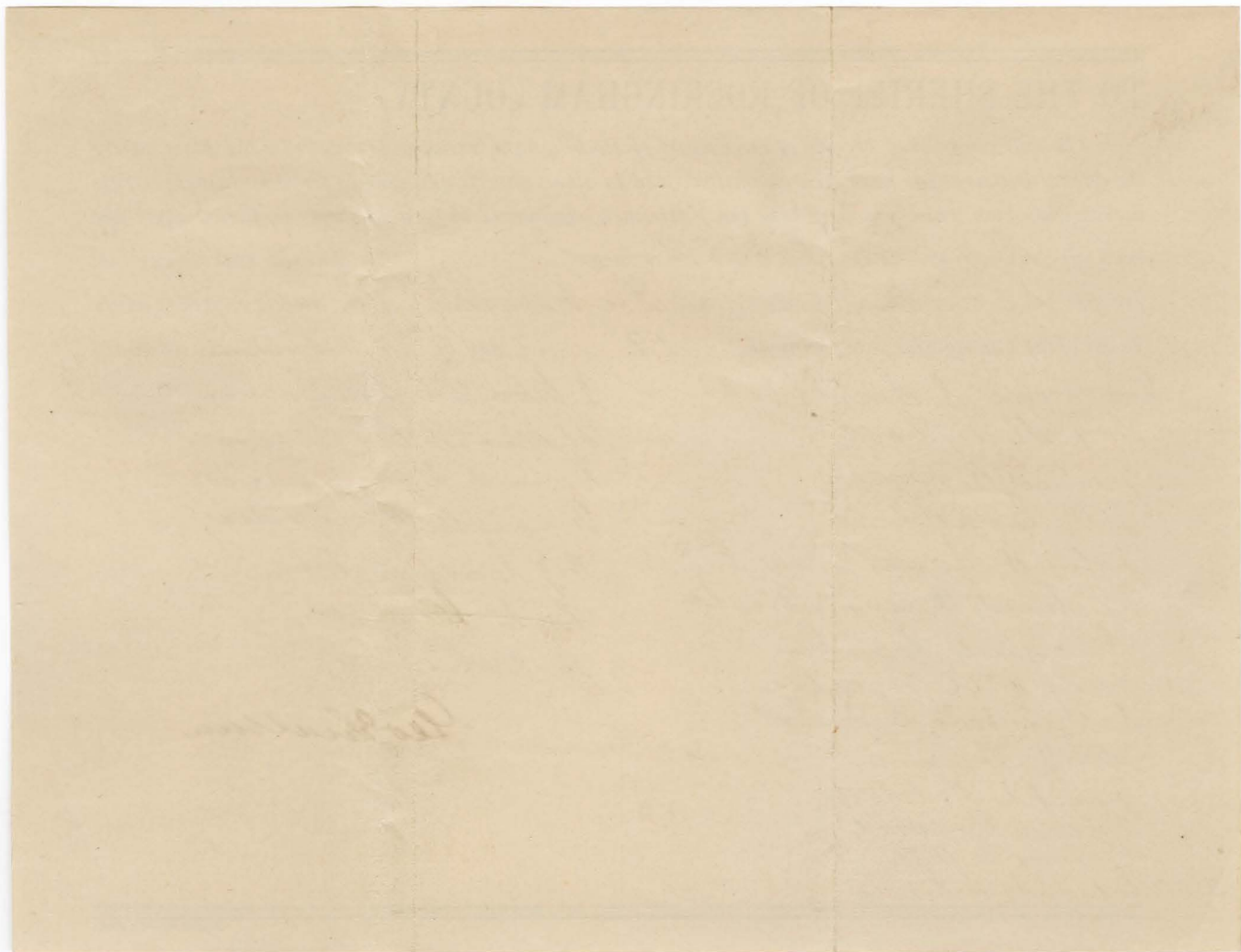
