

State of Virginia - Rockingham County - To wit -

In the County Court of the said County -

The Jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia in and for the City of the County of Rockingham and now attending the said Court - Upon this and present that Joseph Jackson on the day of January in the year 1895 in the said County, in the town of Hillsborough did unlawfully sell wine and spirits, malt liquors and a mixture thereof to one Arthur Bygon by retail, and to the drunk as the facta above said without first having obtained a license therefor according to law against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia -

And the Jurors aforesaid upon their oath aforesaid do further proceed that Joseph Jackson on the day of _____ in the year 1894 within the last twelve months and on divers other days and at divers other times within the last twelve months, in the said County in the town of Hillsborough did unlawfully sell wine, malt spirits, malt liquors and a mixture thereof by retail and to the drunk at the place where sold without first having obtained a license therefor according to law against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia -

This indictment is found in the testimony of Arthur Bygon and also of the witnesses sworn in Court and each before the Grand Jury to give evidence
