I, J. St. Petrie, a Justice of the said Co., do hereby certify that I have this day committed Boaz Shipley, alias Lindsay Shipley, to the Jail of this County, that he may serve or remain there three months confined, and further pay a fine of \$100. for the use of the Commonwealth, or \$11.46 as costs, for unlawfully selling liquor in the streets near Mangin's Store, in Post Republic either in the month of Feb., or March, 1896, also to pay a fine of \$20.00 for carrying a revolver concealed from common observation, on his person, at the Magisterial court in said Co. on the 24th day of July, 1896, in default of paying said fines he is committed to said Jail until said fines are paid, or in case of an appeal from either sentence, until the sentence not appealed is complied with.
