Be it remembered, that on this the 27th day of August 1898, Charles B. Cline and B. G. Patterson personally appeared before me Penabton Bryan a justice of said County and sswally acknowledged themselves to owe the Commonwealth of Virginia as follows, that is to say the said Charles B. Cline the sum of one hundred dollars and the said B. G. Patterson the sum of one hundred dollars of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be levied and for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this Condition that if the said Charles B. Cline shall personally appear before the County Court of said County on the first day of the next Grand Jury term there of him and sure to answer the Commonwealth for a bill of indictment to be preferred to the grand jury in and for the said County, against him the said Charles B. Cline for a felony with which he stands charged, in this that he the said Charles B. Cline did in said County on the 24th day of August 1898 unlawfully, maliciously and feloniously strike and wound one E. A. Shands with intent to maim disfigure ~~disable~~ disable and kill him the said E. A. Shands, and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court, then his recognizance shall be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. Taken and acknowledged
