I command you, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, forthwith to apprehend the said Robert Derron, and to bring him before me or some other Justice of said County to answer the said complaint. And you are required to summon Mr. Jennie Jane Derron, and A. R. Glover, and Charles Glover, to appear and give evidence in behalf of the Commonwealth, on the examination touching the said offence.

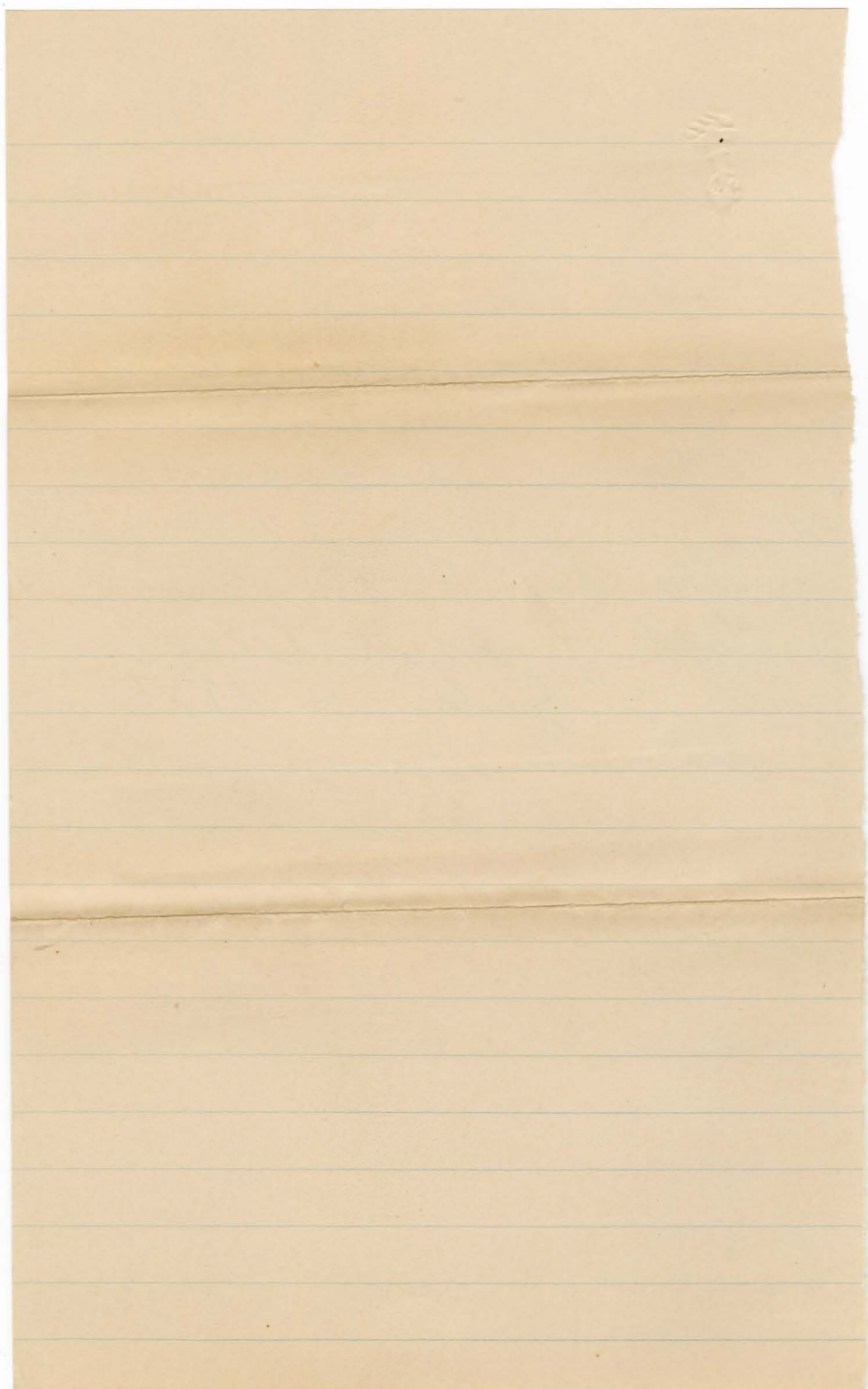

Pridg, a Justice of the said County, on this 27<sup>th</sup> day of August 1900, and made complaint on oath that Robert Derror did <sup>or before</sup> on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1900, in said County declare and threaten that he would blow affiant's down block hearted, and on one occasion before said date exhibited to affiant a pistol with threatening gestures - by reason whereof, he, this Complainant, is afraid and has good cause to fear that the said Robert Derror will do him some grievous bodily injury, and therefore prays he may be required to give surety to keep the peace towards him - And the said J. Glover also says on oath, that he does not make the complaint against the said Robert Derror, nor require such surety from any hatred, malice or illwill but merely for the preservation of his person from injury -

Poole, a Justice of the said County, and severally acknowledged themselves to owe to the Commonwealth of Virginia, that is to say, the said Robert Derror, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, and the said Mina Jane Derror, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and chattels, land and tenements, if he, the said Robert Derror shall make default in the performance of the conditions underwritten. The conditions of the above recognizance is such, that if the above bound <sup>Robert Derror</sup> shall keep the peace, and be of good behavior towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth and especially towards John W. Elvier for and during the term of one year, from the day hereof, then this recognizance shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
