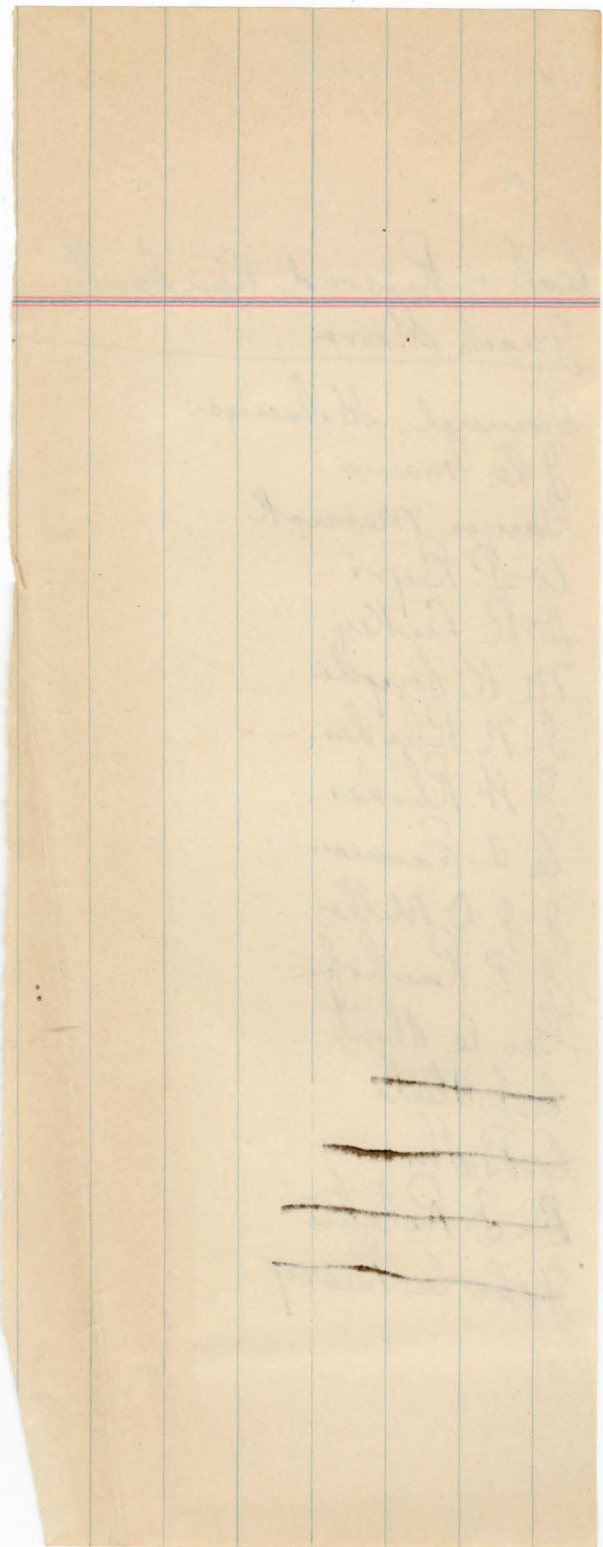

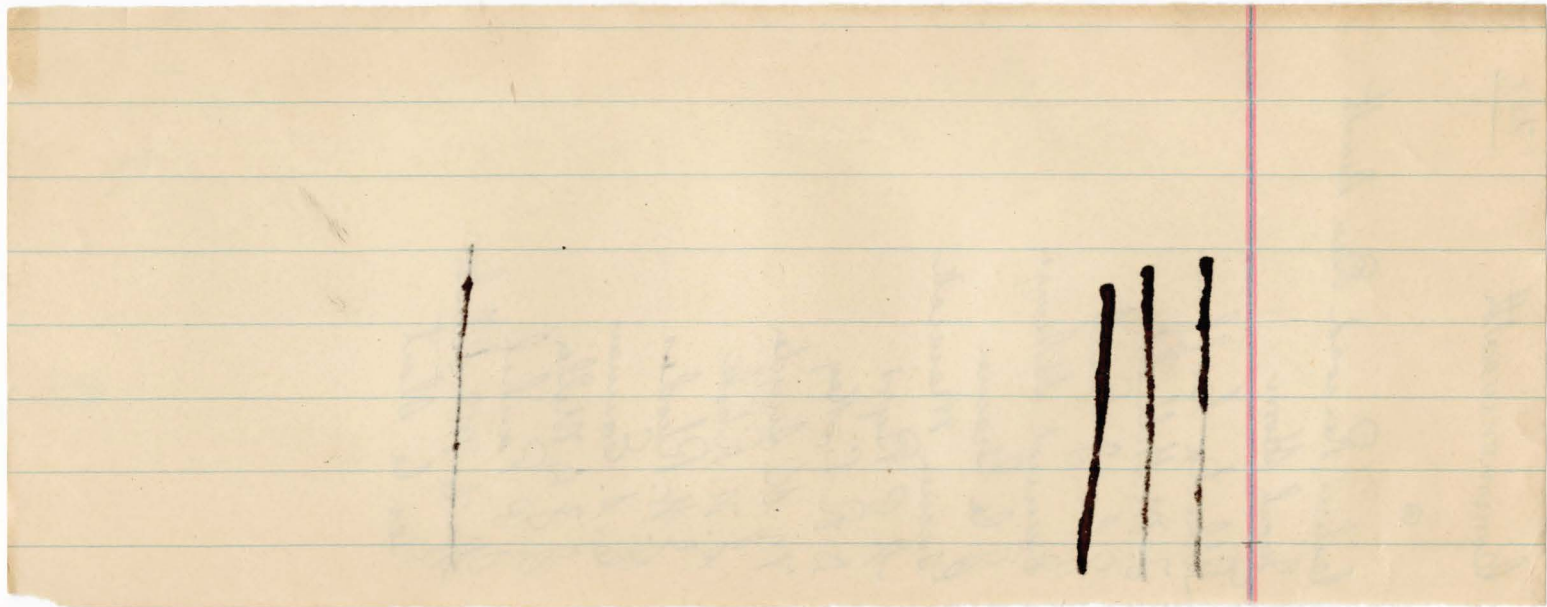

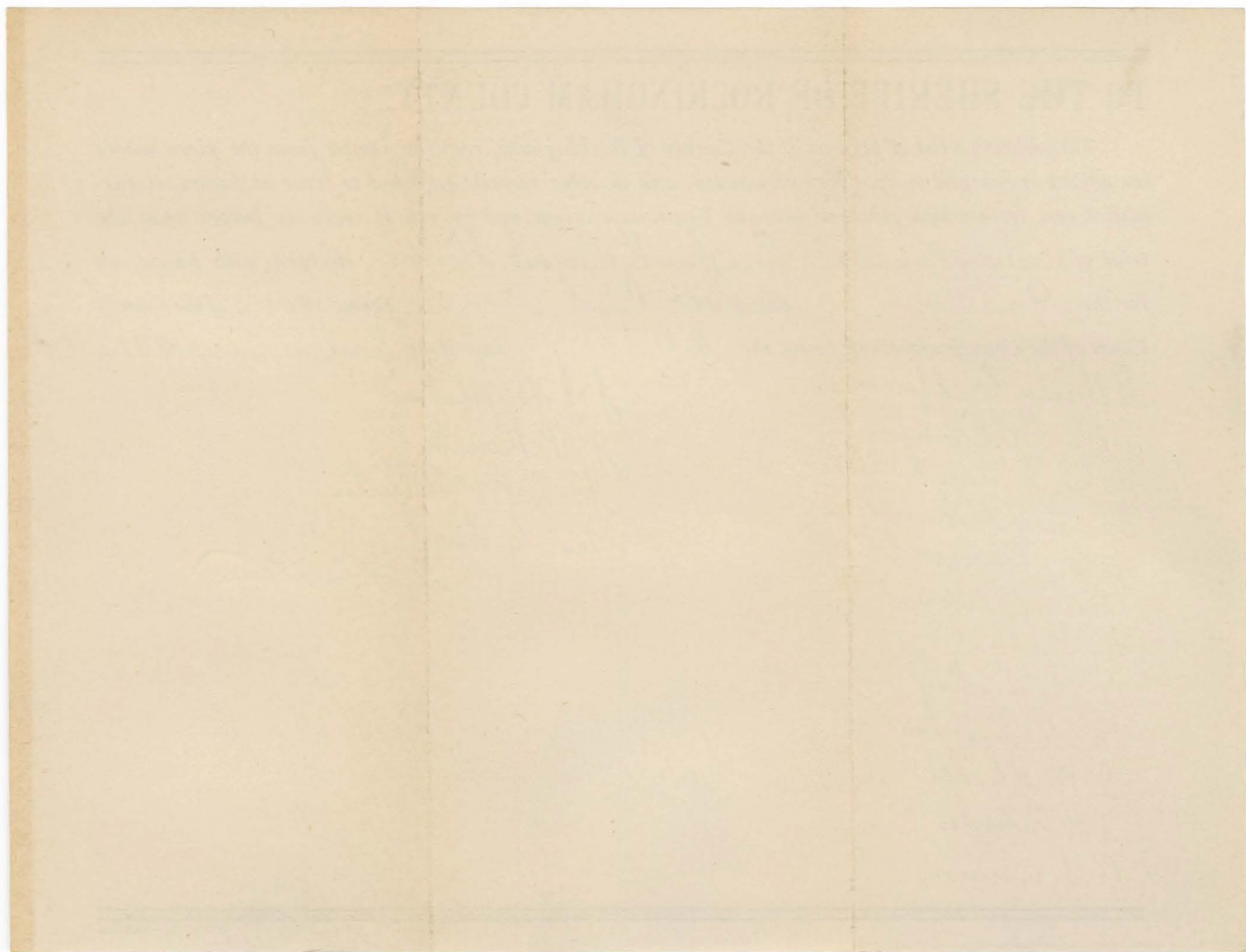

If you find the prisoners or either of them not guilty of the felony aforesaid but guilty of larceny as charged in the indictment you will say so and then ascertain their punishment which may be confinement in jail not less than fifteen days nor more than six months or by fine not less than five nor more than one hundred dollars, or both.

If you find the prisoners or either of them not guilty

you will say so and no more.

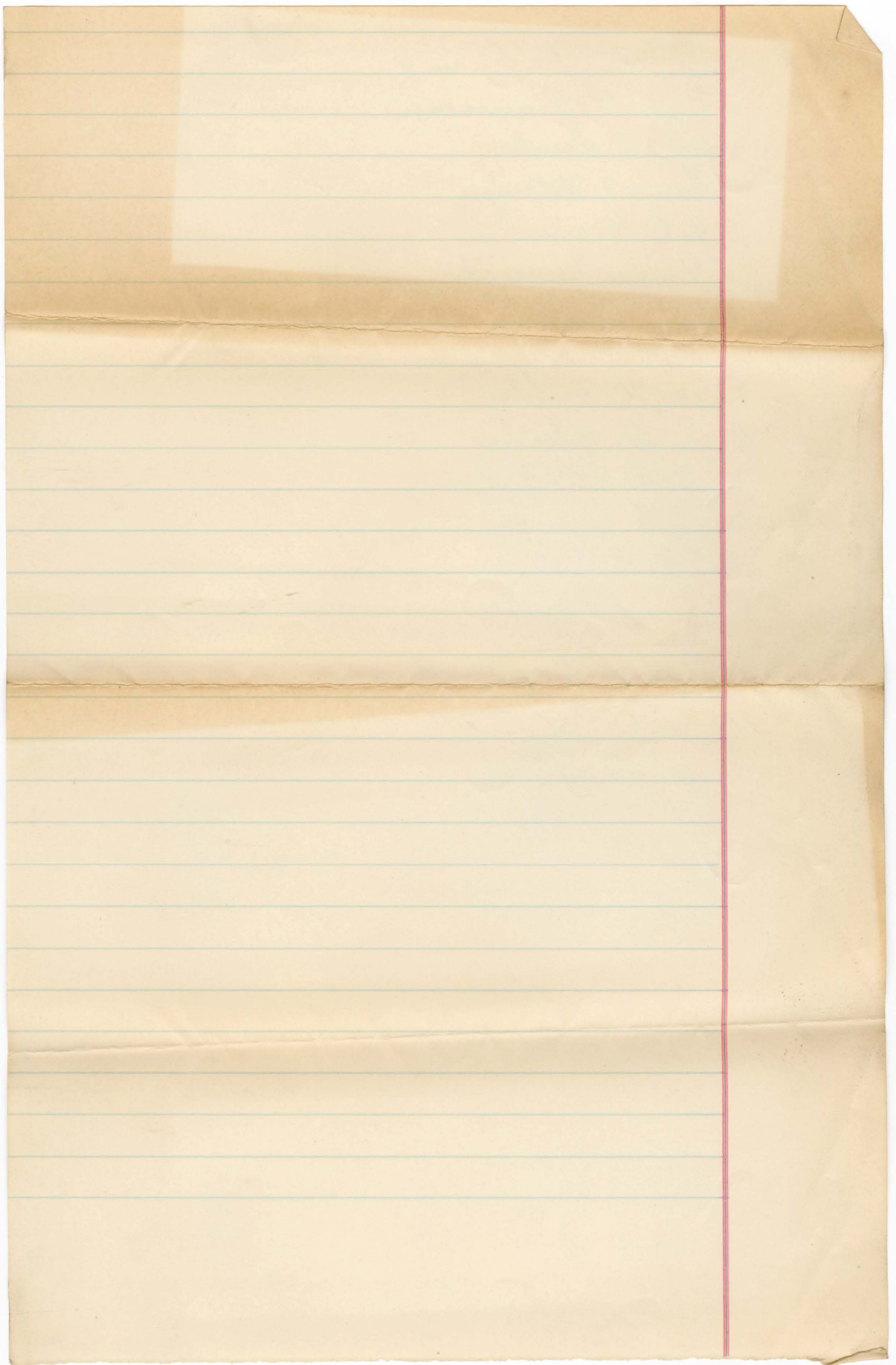
If you find them or either of them guilty of horsebreak-

did feloniously break and enter in the night-time of that day a certain out-house called a chicken house, the property of *Samuel J. Dundore* and not adjoining to or occupied with the dwelling house of said *Samuel J. Dundore*, with intent to commit larceny therein and one chicken of the value of four cents of the goods and chattels of said *Samuel J. Dundore* in said chicken house then being, feloniously did steal, take and carry away

against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

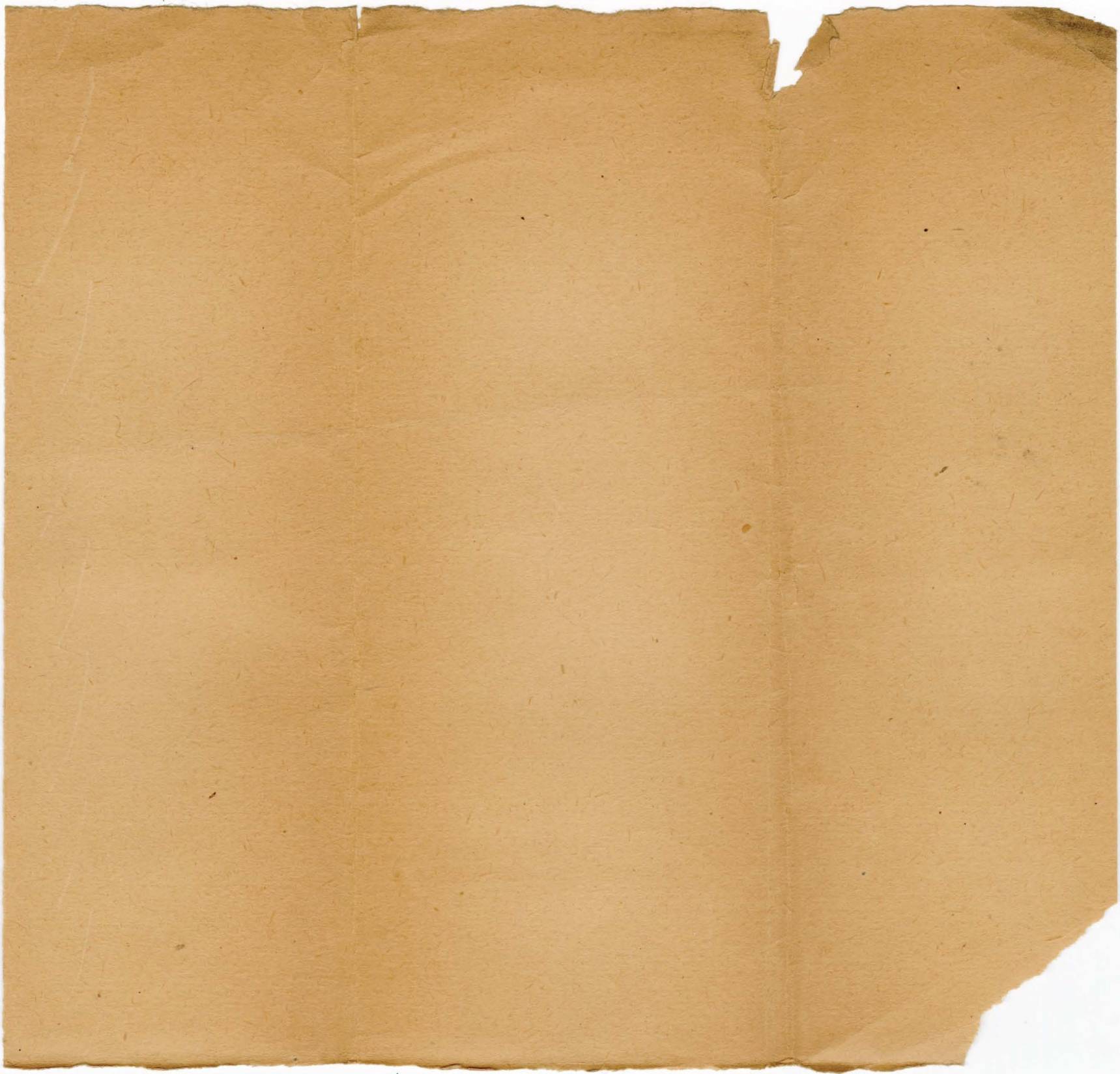

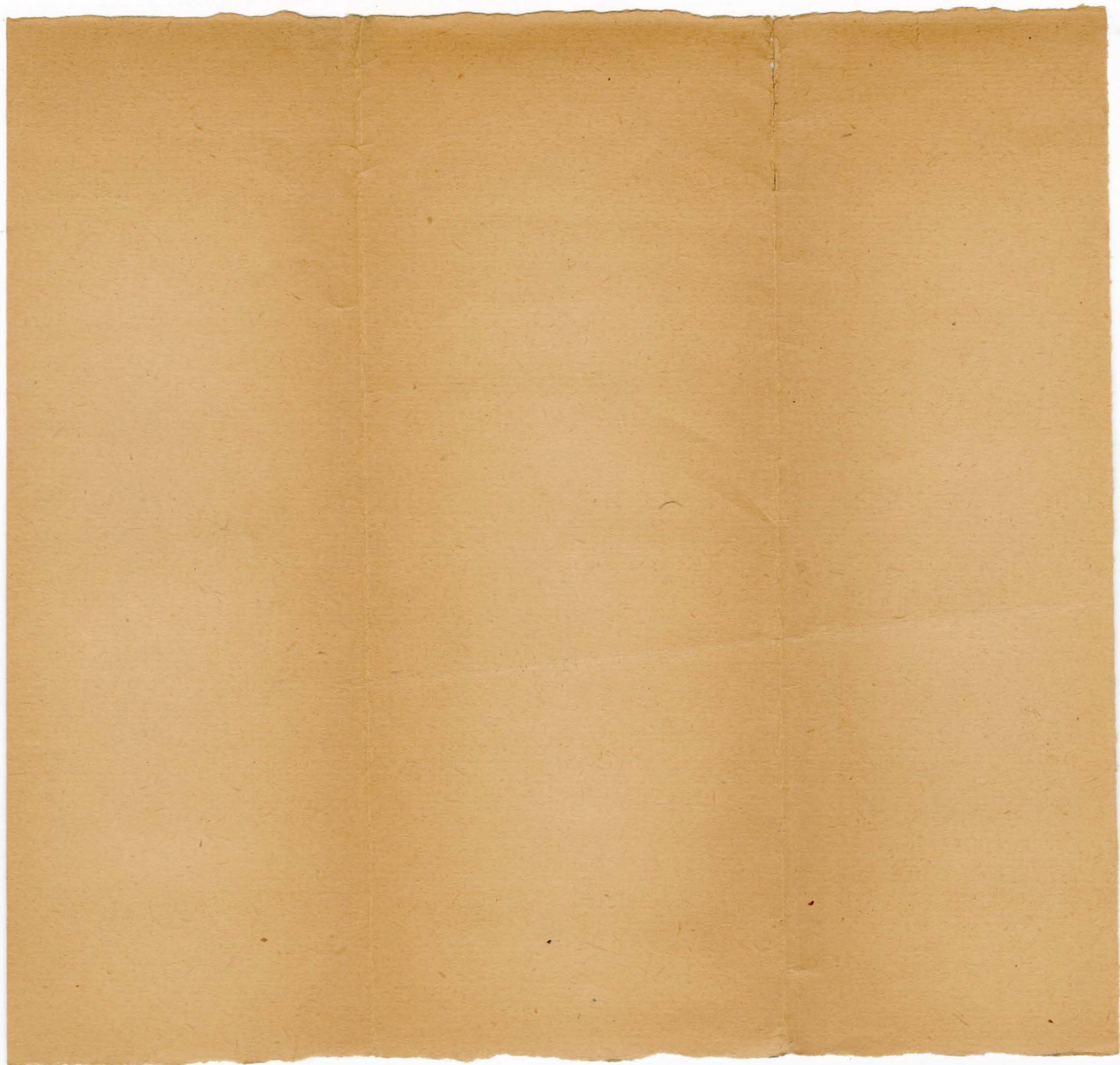
