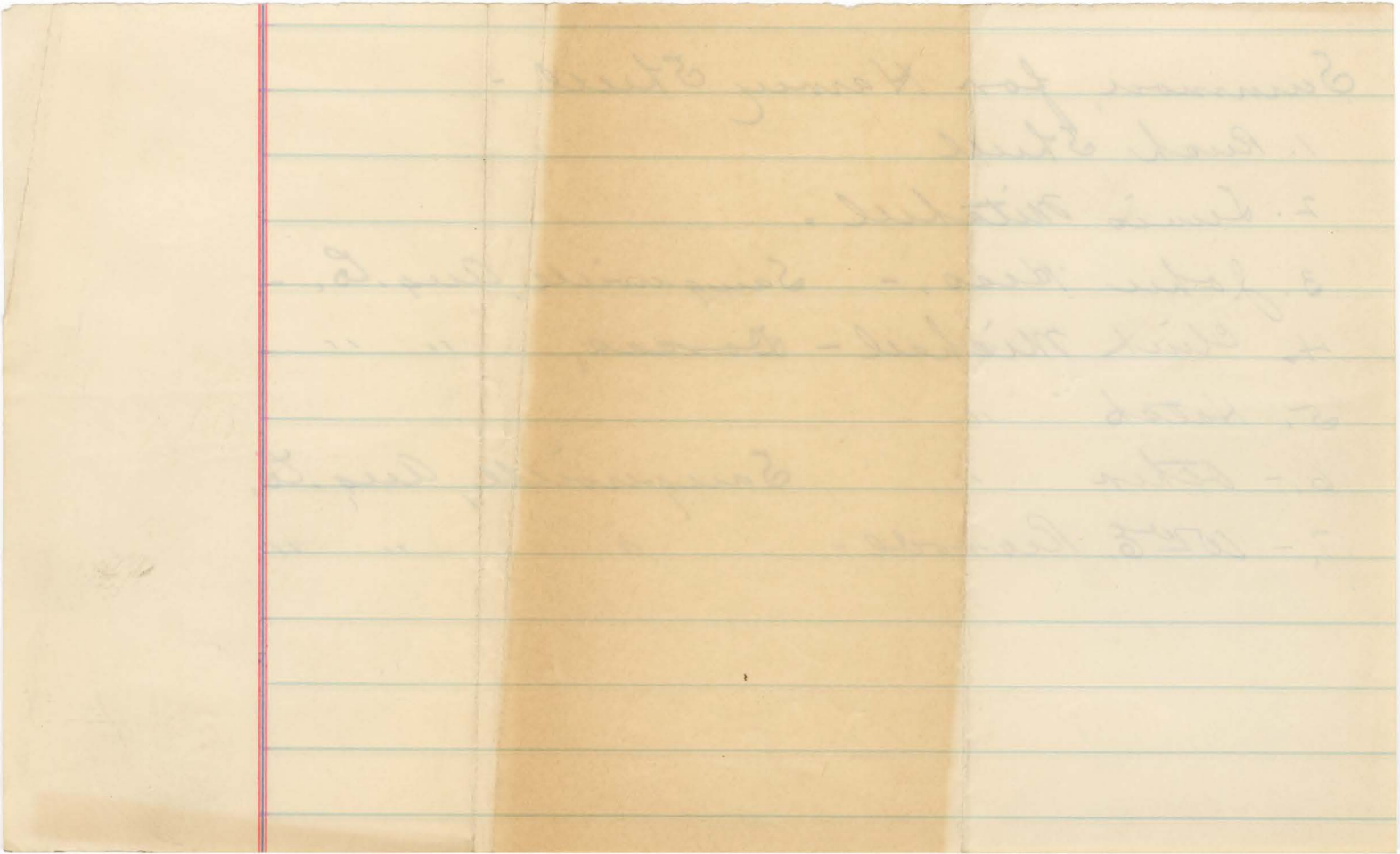

Be it remembered, that on this the 5th day of October 1901 Harvey Shull and David H. Lumer personally appeared before me, Chas. E. Floyd a justice of said county, and severally acknowledged themselves to owe the commonwealth of Virginia, as follows, that is to say, the said Harvey Shull the sum of One Hundred Dollars, and the said David H. Lumer the sum of One Hundred Dollars, of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements to be levied, and for the use of the commonwealth rendered:

Yet upon this condition, that whereas the said Harvey Shull was this day tried before me Chas. E. Floyd a justice of said county, for a misdemeanor, in this, that he on the 15th day of September 1901 did unlawfully carry about his person, hid from common observation a certain revolver or other like weapon, and did shoot in and along a certain public road running by the said W. P. McCall's residence and did then and there injure a certain dog, belonging

to the said W.P. McCall, and by me  
adjudged to pay a fine of Twenty-Five  
(\$25.00) Dollars and the costs of said trial;  
from which judgment and conviction  
the said Harvey Shull took an appeal  
to the next term of the county court  
of said county. Now if the said  
Harvey Shull shall personally appear  
before the said county court, on the  
first day of the next (October) regular  
term thereof, to answer the common-  
wealth for and concerning the said  
offence, whereof he has been found  
guilty and convicted by me, and shall  
not thence depart without leave  
of the said court, then this recognizance  
shall be void, otherwise to remain in  
full force and virtue.

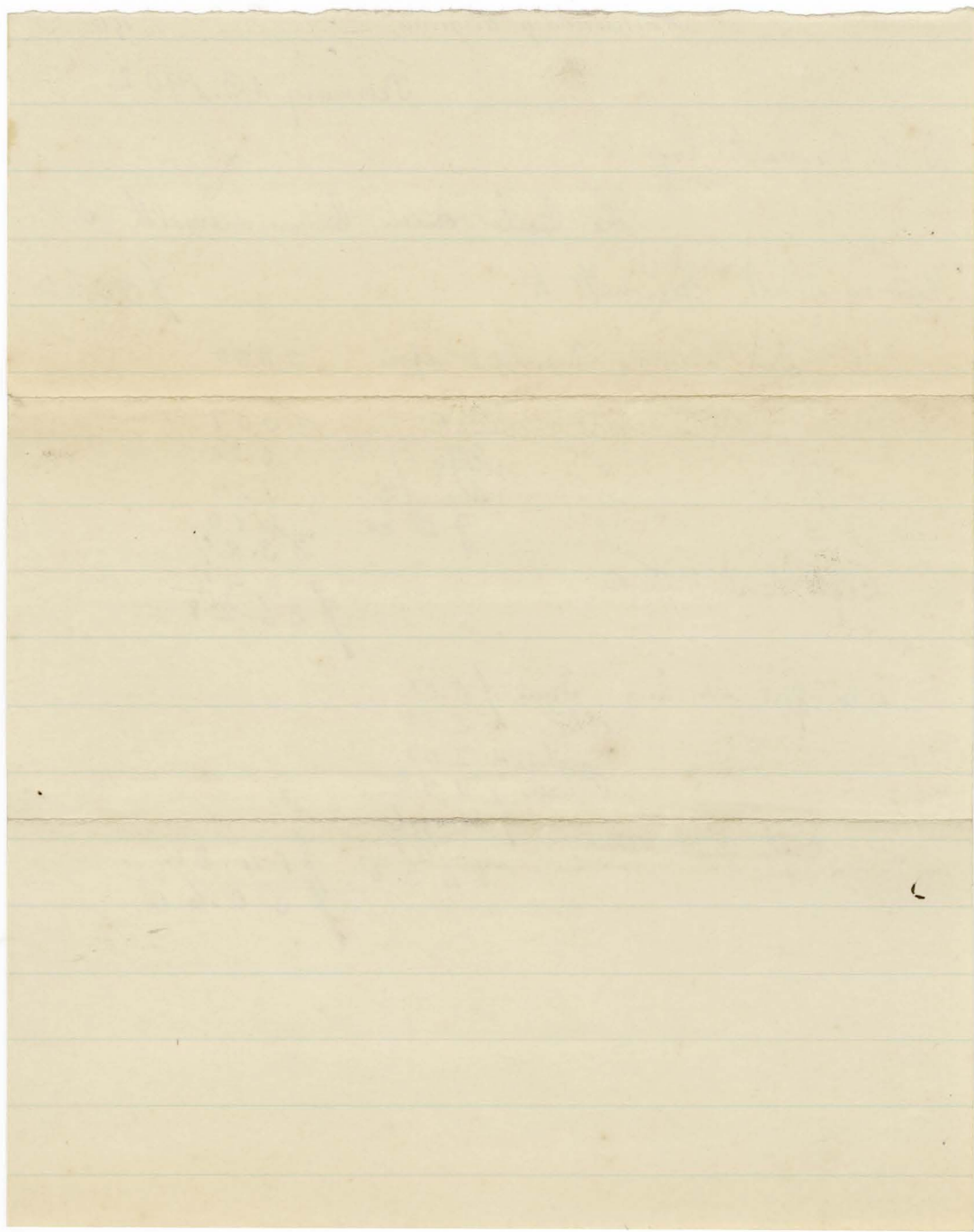

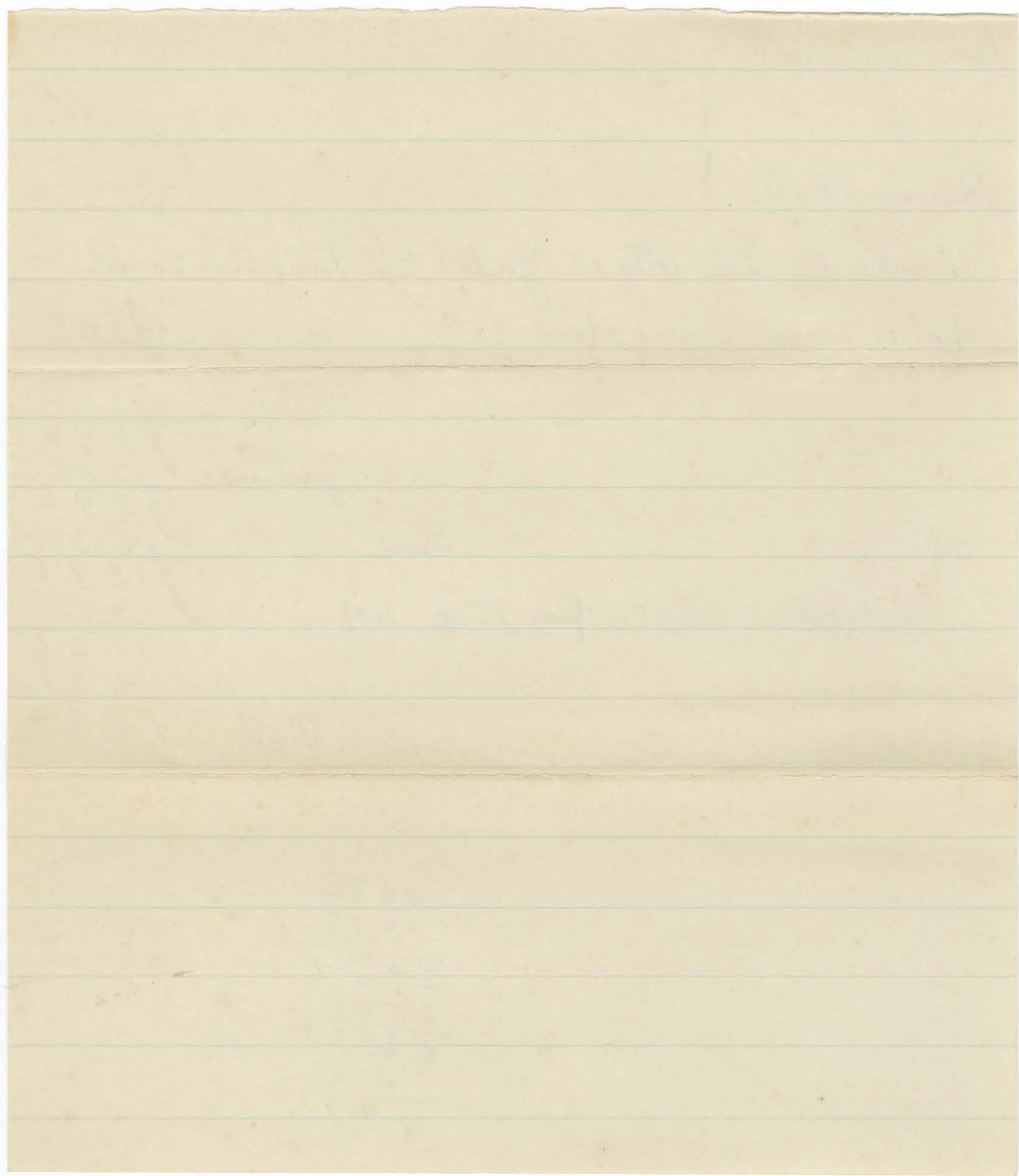

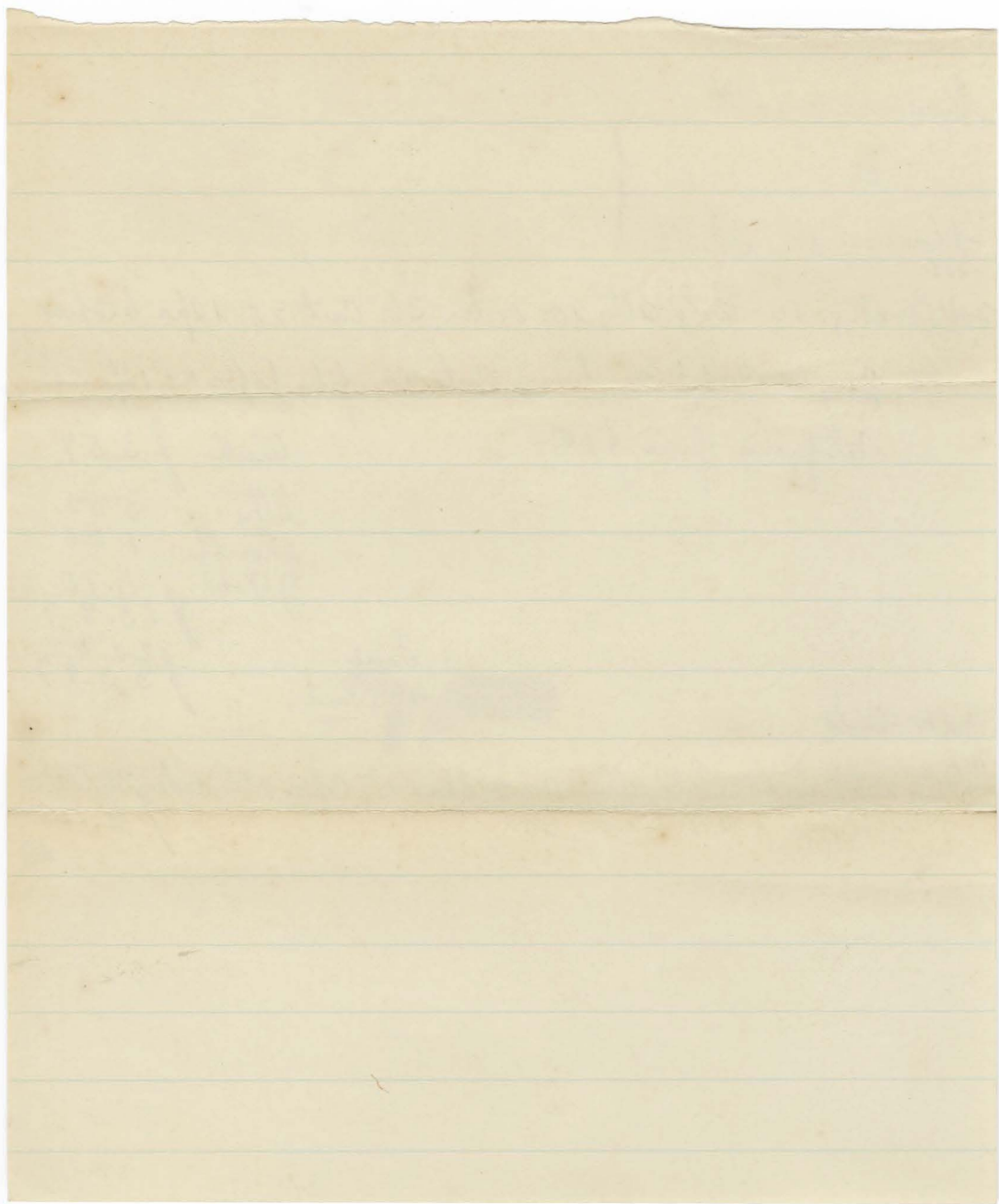
