These are therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me, or some other Justice of the said County, the body of the said

Harry Hoover  
to answer the said complaint, and to be farther dealt with according to law. And you are required to summon

Walter Plaugher, Barbara Gains, Bash Rexrode

to appear and give evidence in behalf of the Commonwealth, on the examination touching the said offence.

Rockingham Co. Court:

Be it remembered that on this 26th day of July 1900. B. F. Eye and Harry G. Hoover personally appeared before me C. E. Floyd a justice of said county, and severally acknowledged themselves to owe the commonwealth of Virginia as follows. That is to say, the said B. F. Eye the sum of One Hundred Dollars and the said Harry G. Hoover the sum of One Hundred Dollars, of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to be levied, and for the use of the commonwealth rendered: Yet upon this condition, that if the said Harry G. Hoover shall personally appear before the county court of said county, on the first day of the next grand jury in and for term thereof, then and there to answer the commonwealth for a bill of indictment, to be preferred to the grand jury in and for said county, against him, the said Harry G. Hoover for a felony by him committed, in this, that he on the 27th day of May 1902 did unlawfully and feloniously did carnally know and abuse one Fanny Plaugher a female child then being under the age of fourteen years, to wit not yet quite eleven years of age, whereof the said Harry G. Hoover stands charged; and shall not depart thence without leave of the said court, then this recognizance shall be void,

otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
