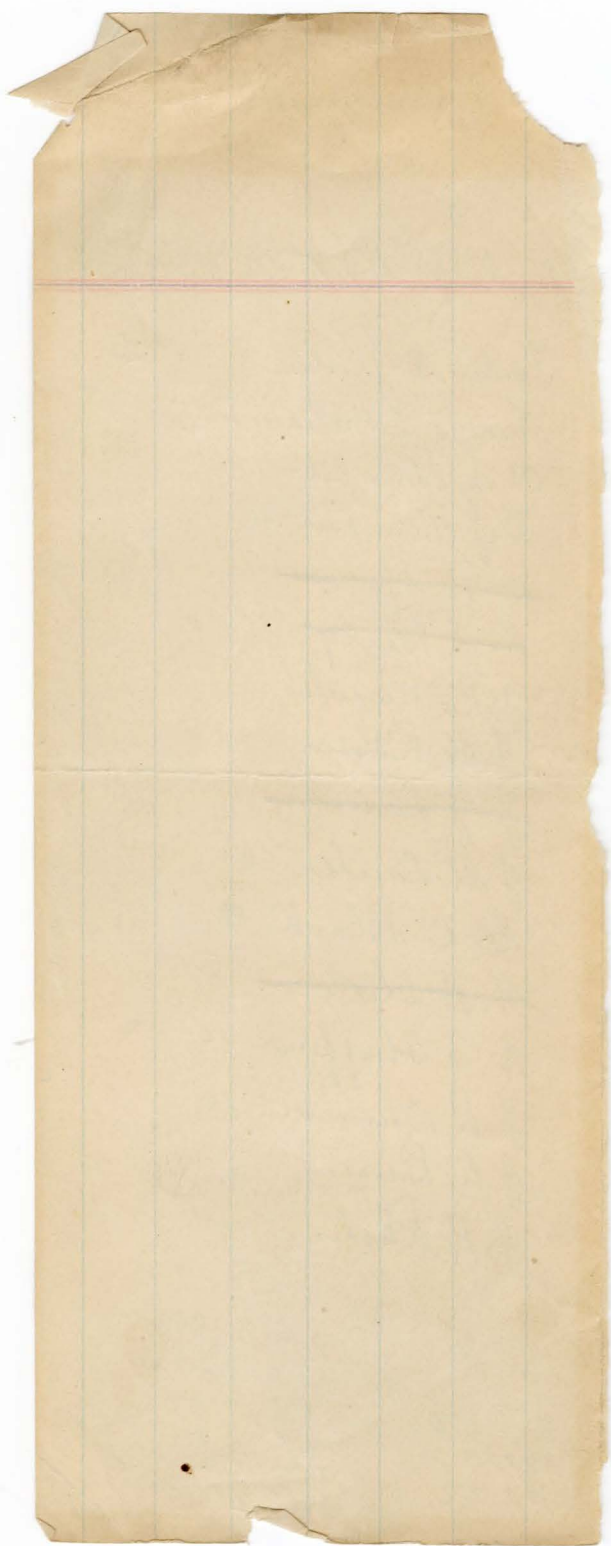

These are therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to command you forthwith to apprehend
and bring before me, or some other Justice of the said County, the body of the said

Rudolph White sometimes called Ori White
to answer the said complaint, and to be farther dealt with according to law. And you are required to summon

to appear and give evidence in behalf of the Commonwealth, on the examination touching the said offence.

THESE ARE TO COMMAND YOU, the said Sheriff, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, forthwith to convey and deliver into the custody of the keeper of the said jail, together with this warrant, the body of Rudolph White sometimes called Orie White charged before me Pendleton Bryan a Justice of the said County of the said _____, on the oath of M. H. Spizer and C. R. Fawley

with a Felony, by _____ committed, in this that the said Rudolph White sometimes called Orie White on the 4th day of May 1902, 189____, the said _____ in the said County did deliberately mingle a certain poison called Paris green with an article of drink known as coffee, in order that the same might be taken by one Orie S. Burton and Annie B. Burton with intent to injure and kill the said Orie S. Burton and Annie B. Burton

and you, the said keeper of the said jail, are hereby required to receive the said Rudolph White sometimes called Orie White into your jail and custody, that he may answer an indictment should one be found for the said offence at the June Term of the County Court of the said County, and him there safely keep until he shall be discharged by due course of law.
