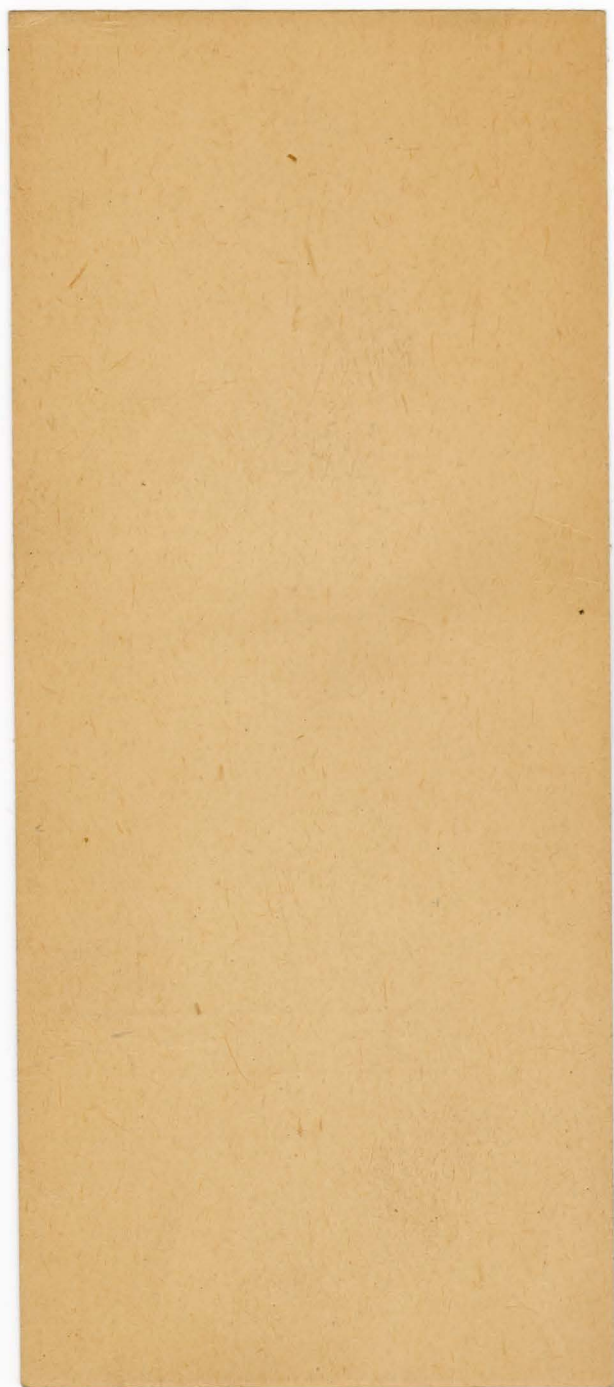

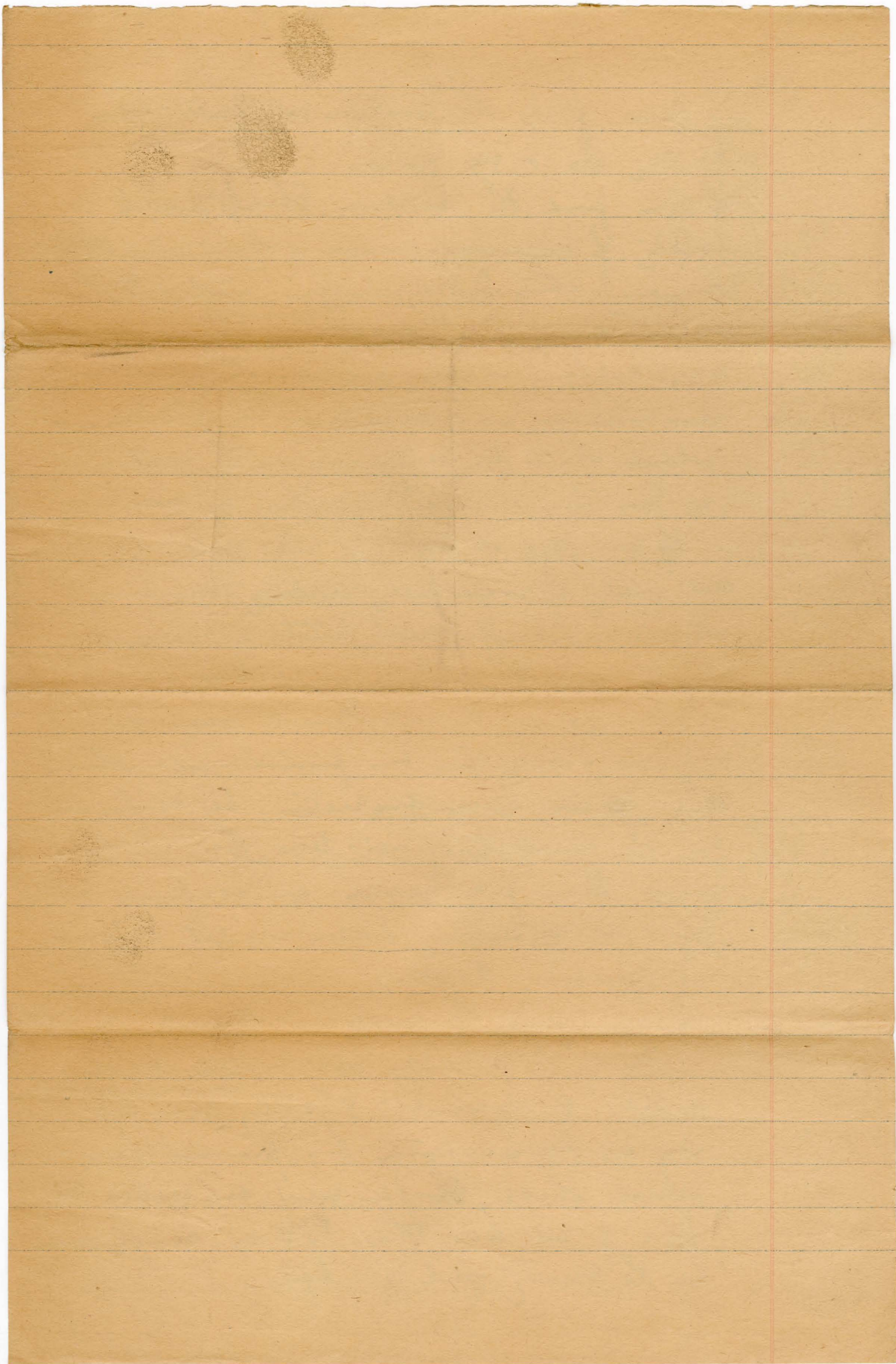

maim, disfigure, disable or kill said
Meyerhoff as charged in the indictment
you will say so + ascertain his punishment -
which shall be confinement in the penitentiary
not less than one nor more than ten years.

If you find the prisoner not-guilty of maliciously
but-guilty of unlawfully ~~wounding~~ wounding
said Meyerhoff with intent to maim, dis-
figure, disable or kill said Meyerhoff
as charged in the indictment - you will
say so + ascertain his punishment - which
shall ~~be~~ in your discretion, be confinement -
in the penitentiary not less than one nor
more than five years or confined in
jail not exceeding twelve months + fined
not exceeding \$500.

If you find the prisoner not-guilty of
either of the felonies aforesaid but-
guilty of assault + battery ^{upon said Meyerhoff} you will
say so + ascertain his punishment -
which shall, ~~be~~ in your discretion be
fine of not less than \$500 or confinement -
in the County jail or both.

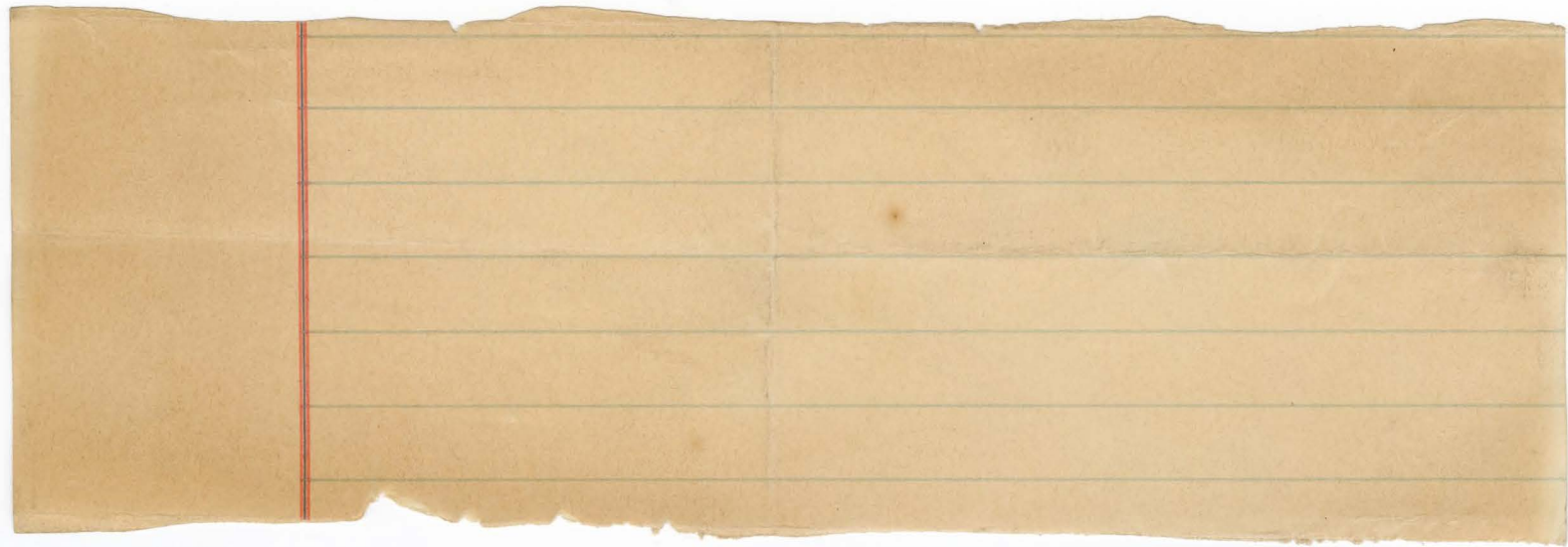
