B. Roller, Mayor of the Town of Harrisonburg and ex officio Justice of the Peace of Rockingham Co. Pount, a justice of the peace of said county, do hereby certify that I have this day committed Aleck Black to the jail of said county, that he may be tried before the circuit court of said county, for a felony by him committed, in this, that he, on the October day of 1905, in the said county, did steal, take and carry away from the warehouse of Coffman Bros. in Harrisonburg, Va., one tier of hay, of the value of \$15.00, then and there being found, of the goods and chattels of Herbert Coffman, and sell said hay to one Ed Siter, without the knowledge and consent of said Herbert Coffman, and convert the value

thereof to his own use - And from evidence before me, upon the trial of said Aleck Black, upon said charge, he pleading guilty, it appears that the said Aleck Black has twice been convicted of Petit Larceny, and sentenced therefor in the United States; the said convictions and sentences being had in courts of competent jurisdiction, in the United States; and ~~for crimes committed,~~ before the date of the alleged offence herein contained - to-wit: on the 2nd day of November 1905, he was tried for Petit Larceny before O.
