

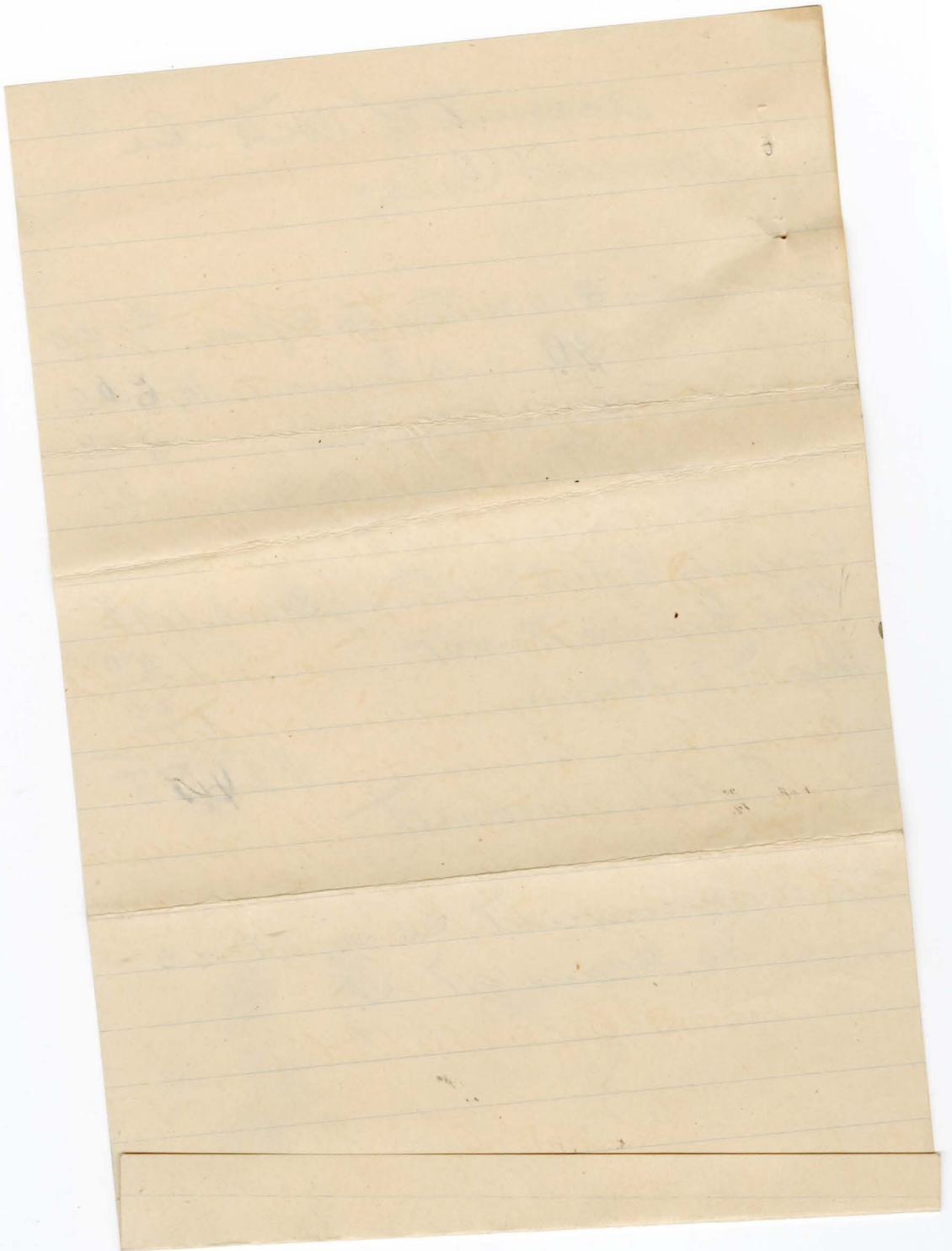

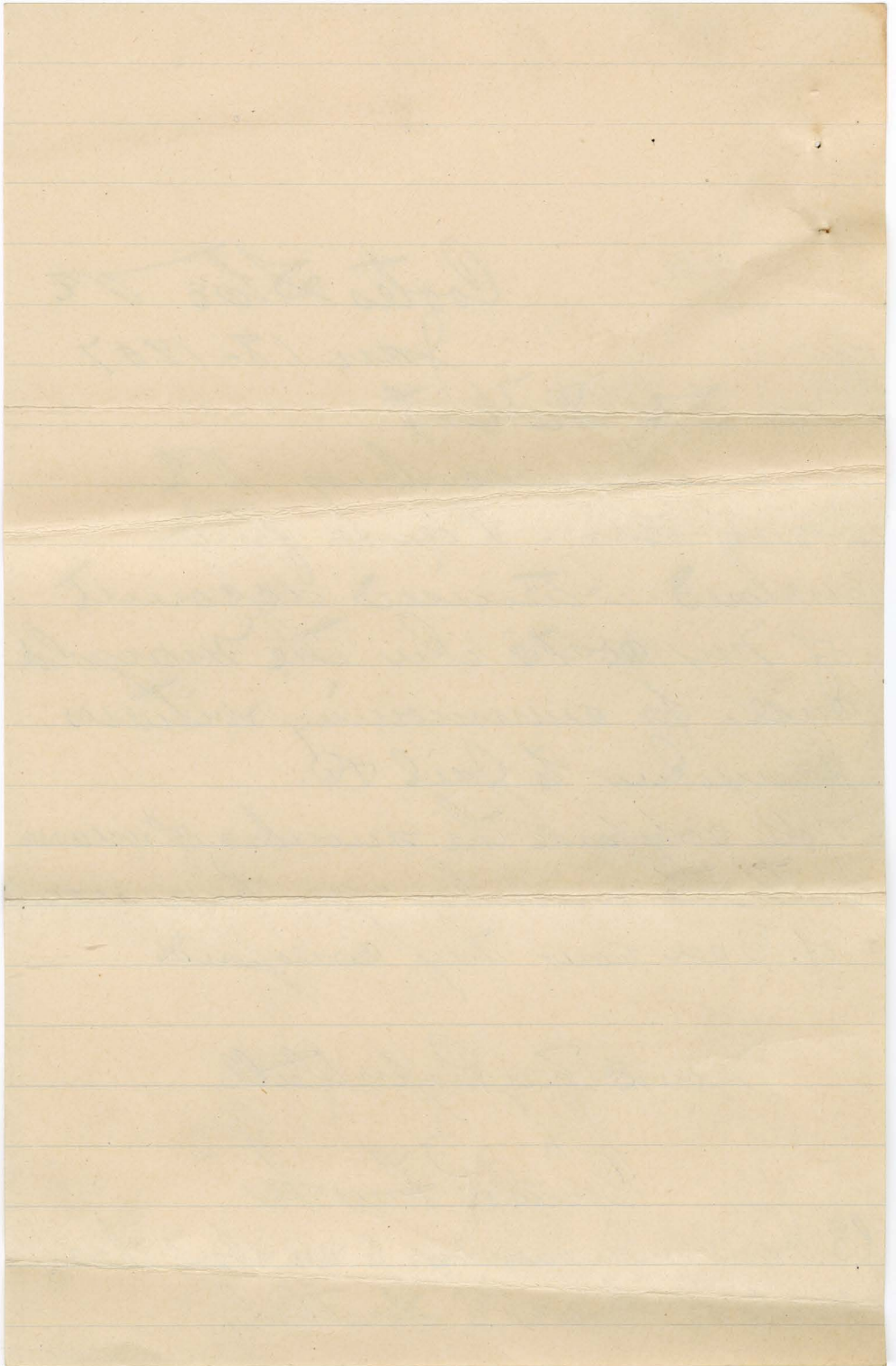

The jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in and for the body of the County of

Rockingham, and now attending the said Court at its

September term, in the year 1906, upon their oaths present that

Israel Mongold

on the 31st day of August, in the year 1906, in the said County,

in and upon one Casper Mongold, then and there being, feloniously, willfully and of his malice aforethought, did make an assault; and that the said Israel Mongold, a certain pistol then and there charged with gunpowder and one leaden bullet, which said pistol he the said Israel Mongold then and there feloniously, willfully and of his malice aforethought, did discharge, and shot off at, against and upon the said Casper Mongold; and that the said Israel Mongold with the leaden bullet aforesaid, out of the pistol by the said Israel Mongold discharged and shot off as aforesaid, then and there feloniously, willfully and of his malice aforethought, did strike, penetrate and wound the said Casper Mongold in and upon the left arm and shoulder, giving to him the said Casper Mongold then and there with the leaden bullet aforesaid, so as aforesaid discharged and shot off out of the pistol aforesaid by the said Israel Mongold in and upon the left arm and shoulder of him the said Casper Mongold, one mortal wound;

~~against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia~~

of which said mortal wound he the said Casper Mongold then and there died. And so the jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do say, that the said Israel Mongold him the said Casper Mongold in the manner and by the means aforesaid, feloniously, willfully and of his malice aforethought, did kill and murder against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.
