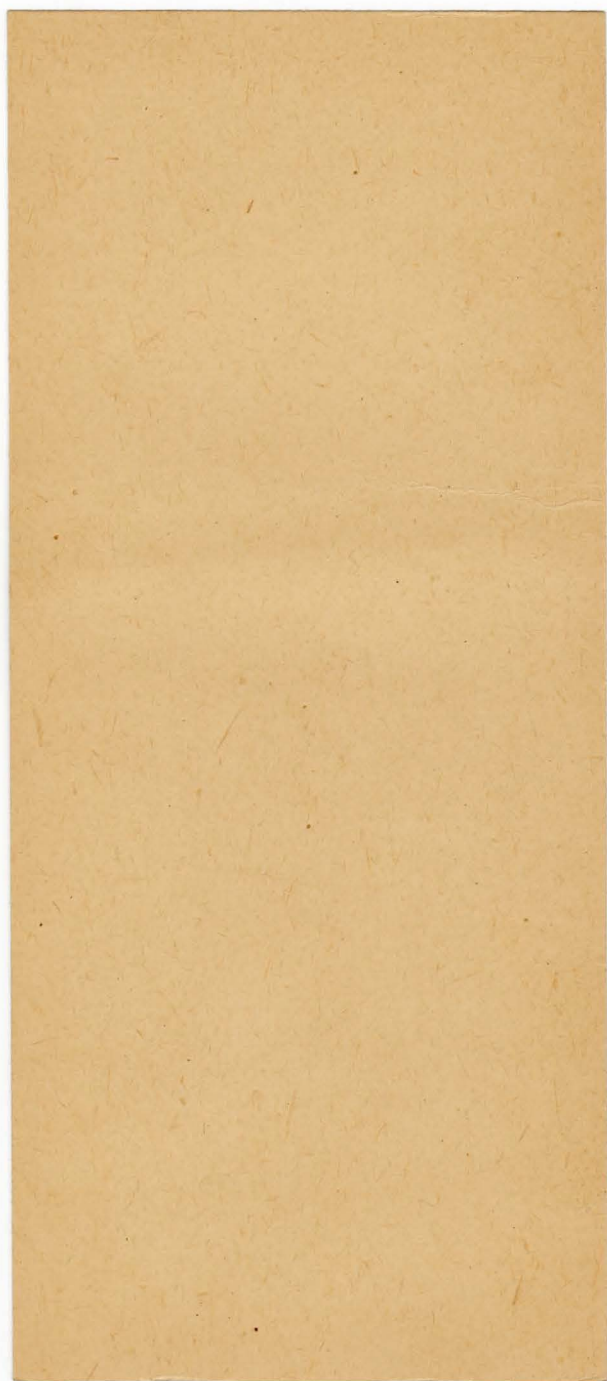

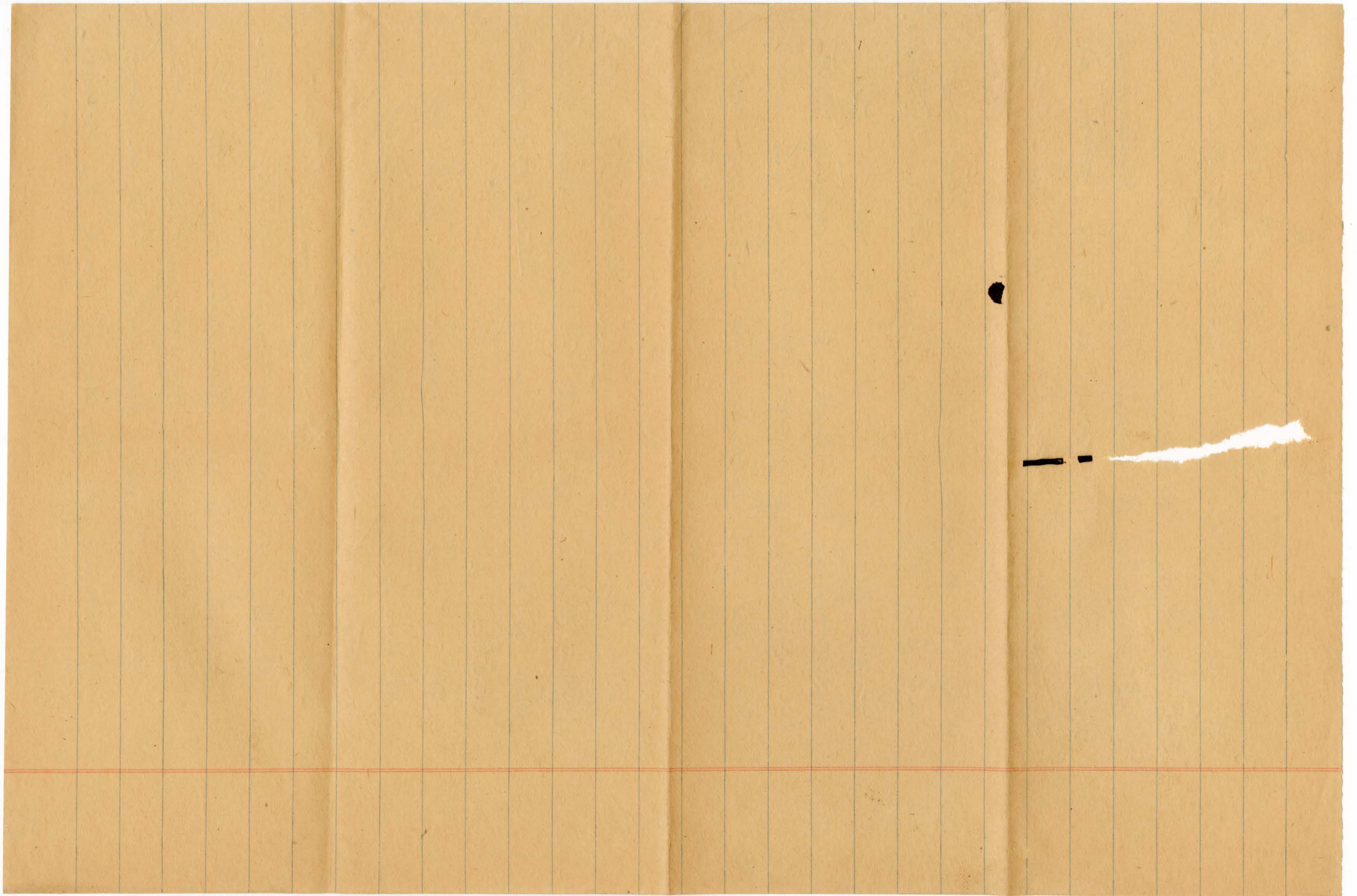


If you find the prisoner not-guilty you will say so and no more.

If you find the prisoner guilty of maliciously cutting Jacob Mowbray in manner & form as charged in the indictment you will say so and ascertain his punishment - which may be confinement in the penitentiary not less than one nor more than ten years.

If you find the prisoner not-guilty of maliciously but guilty of unlawfully cutting or wounding Jacob Mowbray you will say so and ascertain his punishment - which may be confinement in the penitentiary not less than one nor more than five years or in your discretion confinement in jail not exceeding twelve months and fined not exceeding ~~\$500~~ five hundred dollars.

If you find the prisoner not-guilty of maliciously nor guilty of unlawfully cutting or wounding said Mowbray as charged in the indictment - but guilty of assault and battery upon Jacob Mowbray you will say so and ascertain his punishment - which may be fine of not less than \$500 or confinement in the County jail or both.
