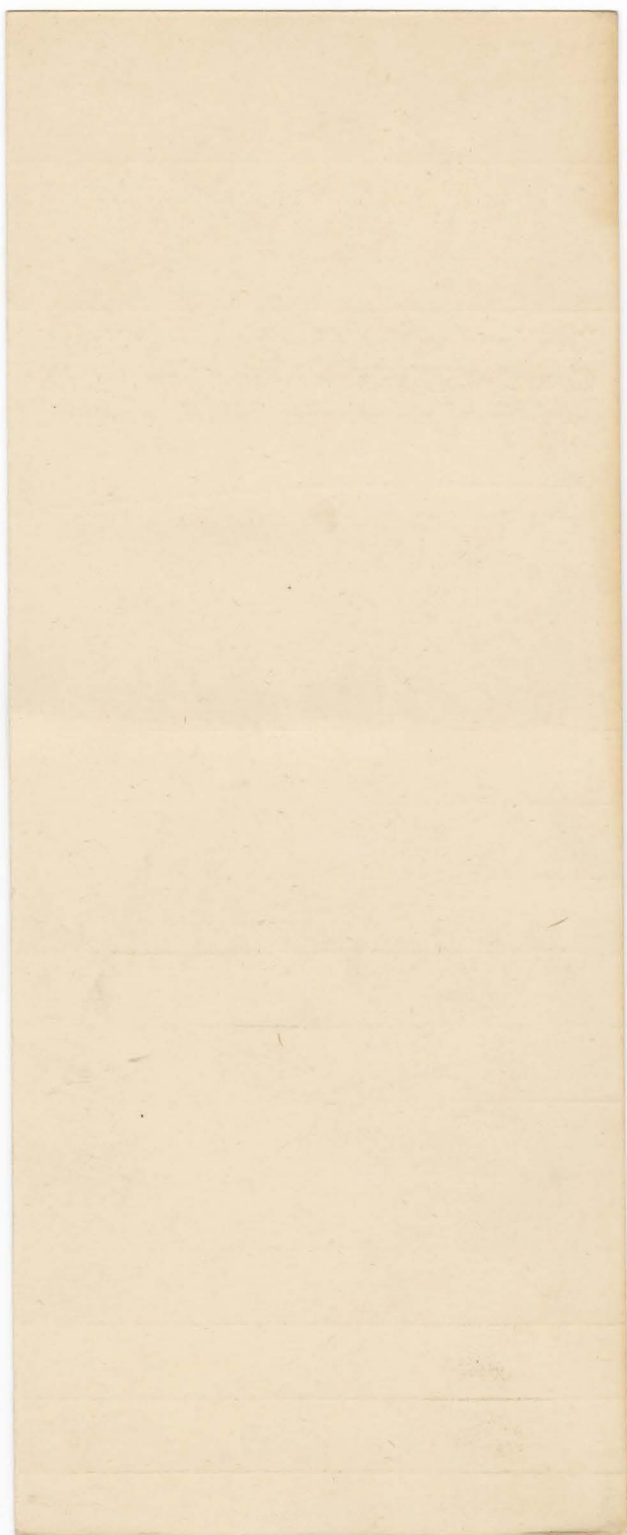

Mrs Mallinda Eaton Nancy Eaton all born in Denmark to appear and give evidence in behalf of the Commonwealth, on the examination touching the said offence.

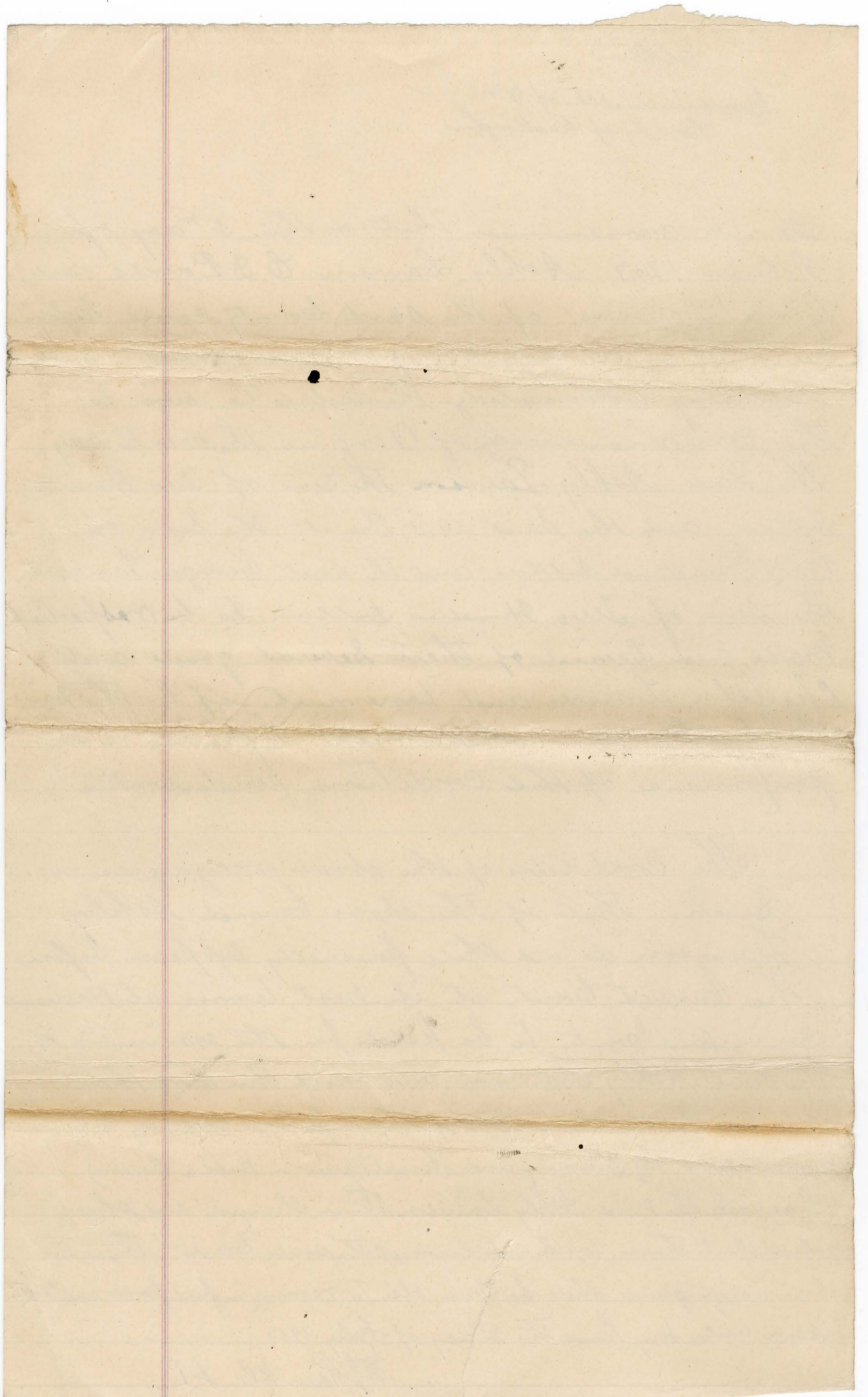

Be it remembered That on this 3rd day of February 1907 Ashley Lawson C. D. Powell and George Lawson of the said County came before me W. J. Prunkle a Justice of the said County, and severally acknowledge themselves to owe to the Commonwealth of Virginia that is to say the said Ashley Lawson the sum of Two Hundred Dollars and the said C. D. Powell the sum of Two Hundred Dollars and the said George Lawson the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and Chattels, Lands and Tenements, if he the said Ashley Lawson shall make default in the performance of the conditions underwritten

The Conditions of the above recognizance is such. That if the above bound Ashley Lawson do and shall personally appear before the Circuit Court at its next Term at Harrison in said County to be held for the examination of the said Ashley Lawson and shall then and there answer the Commonwealth of Virginia for and concerning a certain Misdemeanor (by shooting and threats used in public Road) where with the said Ashley Lawson stands charged and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court then the above recognizance shall be void else to remain in full force and Virtue
