CERTIFICATE OF COMMITMENT FOR TRIAL *on Appeal*

VIRGINIA, COUNTY OF ROCKINGHAM---To-wit:

To the Clerk of the Circuit Court of said County:

I, *Wm. J. Pounts*, a justice of the peace of said county, do hereby certify that I have this day committed *Zach Couley* to the jail of said county, that he may be tried before the circuit court of said county, for a ~~felony~~ *misdemeanor* by him committed, in this, that he, on the *9<sup>th</sup>* day of *May*, 190*8*, in the said county, *did* unlawfully behave in a riotous and disorderly manner on train No. 3, a passenger train of the C. & W. Railway - and upon trial, was convicted and adjudged to pay a fine of *\$50.00* and *\$9.30* costs, and imprisonment in Rockingham Co. Jail for six months from this day, and thereafter until said fine and costs - from which judgment defendant *appeals*, and not offering bail as committed to said jail.
