Poindexter*, a justice of the peace of said county, do hereby certify that I have this day committed *Cap Taus* to the jail of said county, that he may be tried before the circuit court of said county, for a felony by him committed, in this, that he, on the *4th* day of *April*, 190*8*, in the said county, *did* unlawfully and feloniously take and carry away from the person of one *Wm. M. McCartney*, one gold ring of the value of *\$6.75* and one *500* Bill and two *100* Bills money of the United States, and some loose change, the amount not known, then and there being the property of said *Wm. M. McCartney*.
