IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF SAID COUNTY:

The jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in and for the body of the County of Rockingham, and now attending the said Court at its September term, in the year 1909, upon their oaths present that D. E. Croushorn on the 12th day of June, in the year 1909, in the said County, did with force and arms in and upon the body of one Lewis Turner, in the peace of said Commonwealth then and there being, feloniously and wilfully make an assault and that the said D. E. Croushorn a certain pistol of the value of five dollars then and there charged with gunpowder and leaden bullet, which said pistol he the said D. E. Croushorn in his right hand then and there had and held, then and there feloniously and wilfully did discharge and shoot off to, against and upon the said Lewis Turner; and that the said D. E. Croushorn with the leaden bullet aforesaid out of the pistol by the said D. E. Croushorn discharged and shot off as aforesaid then and there feloniously and wilfully did strike, penetrate and wound the said Lewis Turner in and upon the lower and right side of the back of said Lewis Turner; giving to him the said Lewis Turner, then and there with the leaden bullet aforesaid so as aforesaid discharged and shot off in and upon the lower and right side of the back of said Lewis Turner one mortal wound; of which said mortal wound he the said Lewis Turner then and there died. And so the jurors aforesaid upon their oath aforesaid do say that the said D. E. Croushorn him the said Lewis Turner, in the manner and by the means aforesaid feloniously, wilfully and unlawfully did shoot and kill and commit manslaughter against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Crowder with the leaden bullet aforesaid out of the pistol by the
said D. E. Crowder discharged and shot off as aforesaid then and
there feloniously and willfully did strike, penetrate and wound the
said Lewis Turner in and upon the lower and right side of the back of
said Lewis Turner; giving to him the said Lewis Turner, then and there
with the leaden bullet aforesaid as aforesaid discharged and shot
off in and upon the lower and right side of the back of said Lewis
Turner one mortal wound; of which said mortal wound he the said Lewis
Turner then and there died. And so the jurors aforesaid upon their
oath aforesaid do say that the said D. E. Crowder him the said
Lewis Turner, in the manner and by the means aforesaid feloniously,
willfully and unlawfully did shoot and kill and commit manslaughter
against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.
