feloniously forge a certain order for the payment of money commonly called a check purporting to be the order or draft of one B. L. Saunders upon the Petersburg Savings and Insurance Co., a bank for the payment of one hundred and fifty Dollars and did then and there feloniously utter and attempt to employ the same as a true and genuine check the said W. A. Hyde knowing the same to be forged with intent to defraud

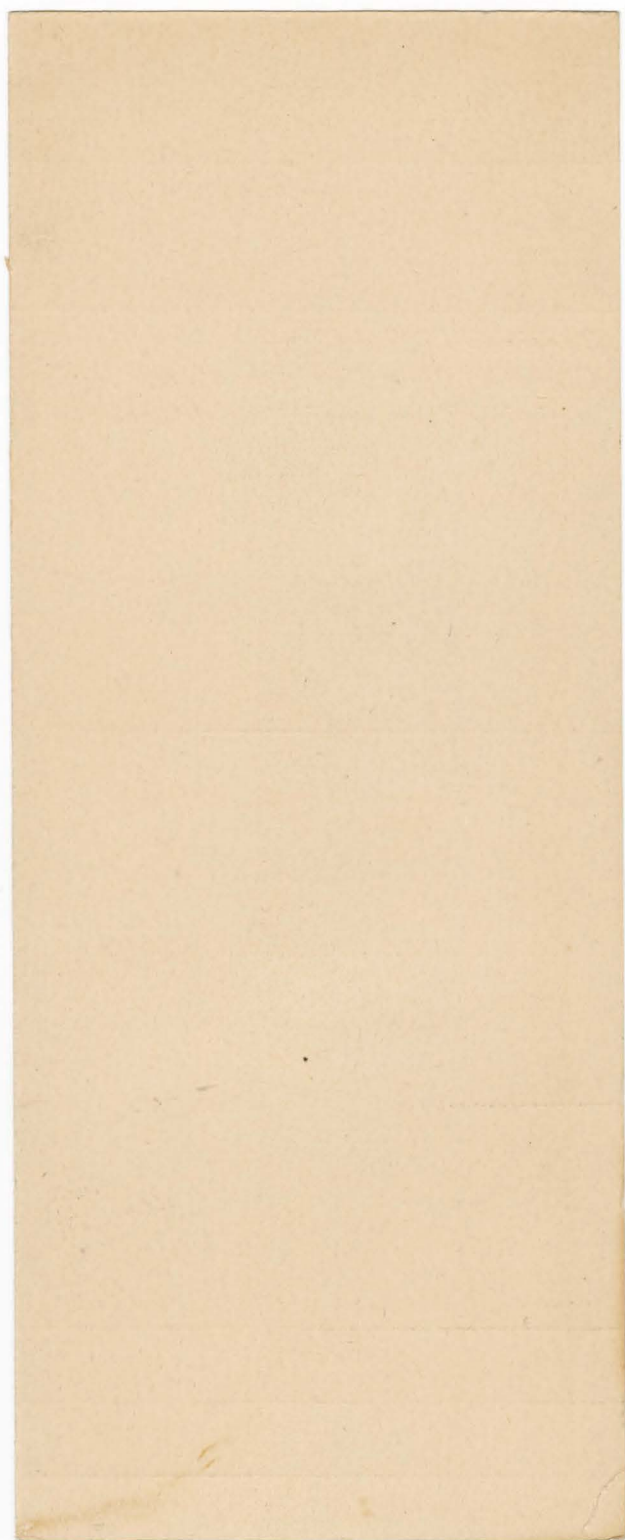

WHEREAS, at a Circuit Court held in and for the County of Rockingham in the month of December, in the year one thousand nine hundred and nine

was convicted of Forgery and was thereupon sentenced to ~~be imprisoned in the~~ the public roads for the term of Two (2) Years, and whereas it appears to the Executive that he is a fit subject for clemency,

THEREFORE, I, WM. HODGES MANN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, have, by virtue of authority vested in me, pardoned and do hereby pardon the said Clarence Hyde # 9175 and do order that he be forthwith discharged from imprisonment, but upon the terms and conditions following, namely:

That the said Clarence Hyde # 9175 will conduct himself in the future as a good, law-abiding citizen; and if ever again he be found guilty of a violation of the penal laws of the Commonwealth this pardon shall be null and void.

Given under my hand and under the lesser seal of the Commonwealth, at Richmond, this Thirtieth day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and ten, and in the one hundred and thirty-fifth year of the Commonwealth.
