

COMMITMENT TO ANSWER INDICTMENT.

VIRGINIA, COUNTY OF ROCKINGHAM---TO-WIT:

To the Sheriff of said County, and to the
Keeper of the Jail thereof:

These are, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to command you, the said Sheriff,
forthwith to convey and deliver into the custody of the keeper of said jail, together with this warrant, the body of.....

Charles Winters and Peter Kingan, charged be-
fore me, Wm. J. Poind, a justice of

the peace of said county, on oath of C. W. Peure & W. J. Shoualla misdeameour
with a felony

by him committed, in this, that they, the said Charles Winters & Peter Kingan & since
on the

14th day of February, 1909, in said county, have been unlawfully
leading a life of strolling in idleness, being able to work,
and apparently having no means of support, and otherwise
having the appearance and characteristics of Negroes.
And upon examination being found guilty as charged
it is adjudged that they be each confined in the
jail of Rockingham County, Virginia for a period
of three months from this date

.....and you, the keeper of the said jail, are hereby required to receive the said

Charles Winters and Peter Kingan into your jail and custody, that he may be
tried for the said offence before the county court of said county, and him there safely keep, until he shall be discharged
