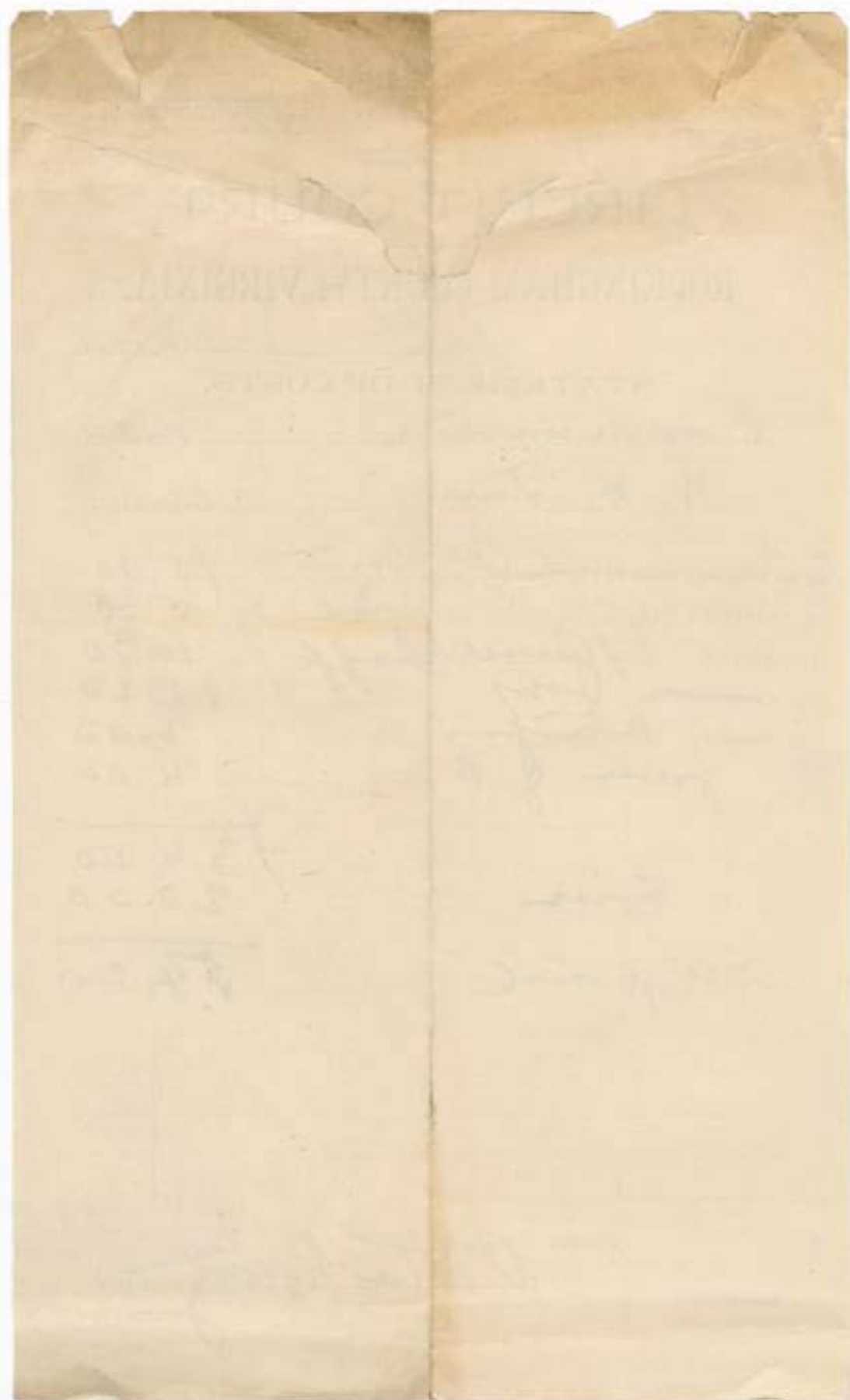

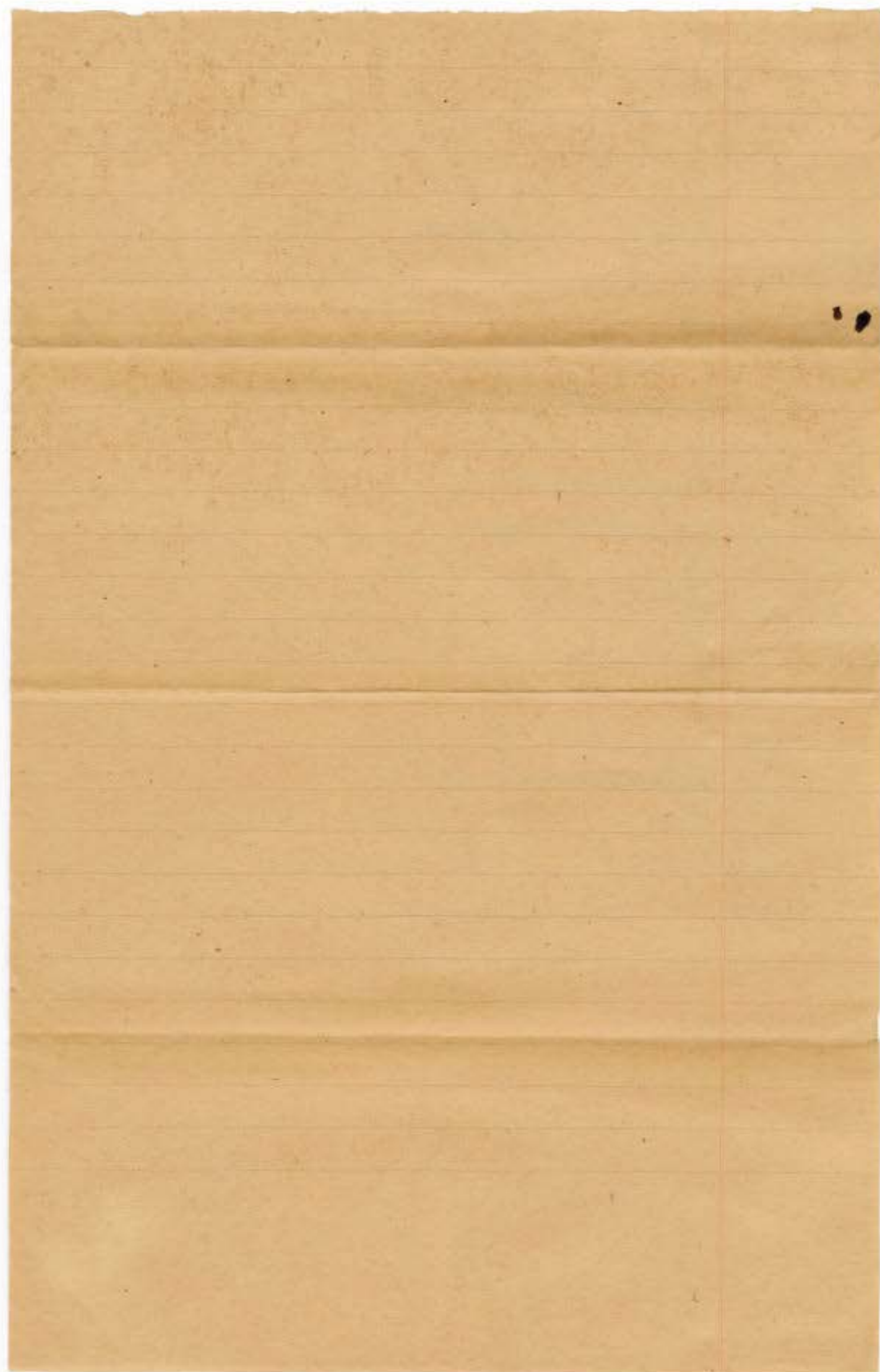

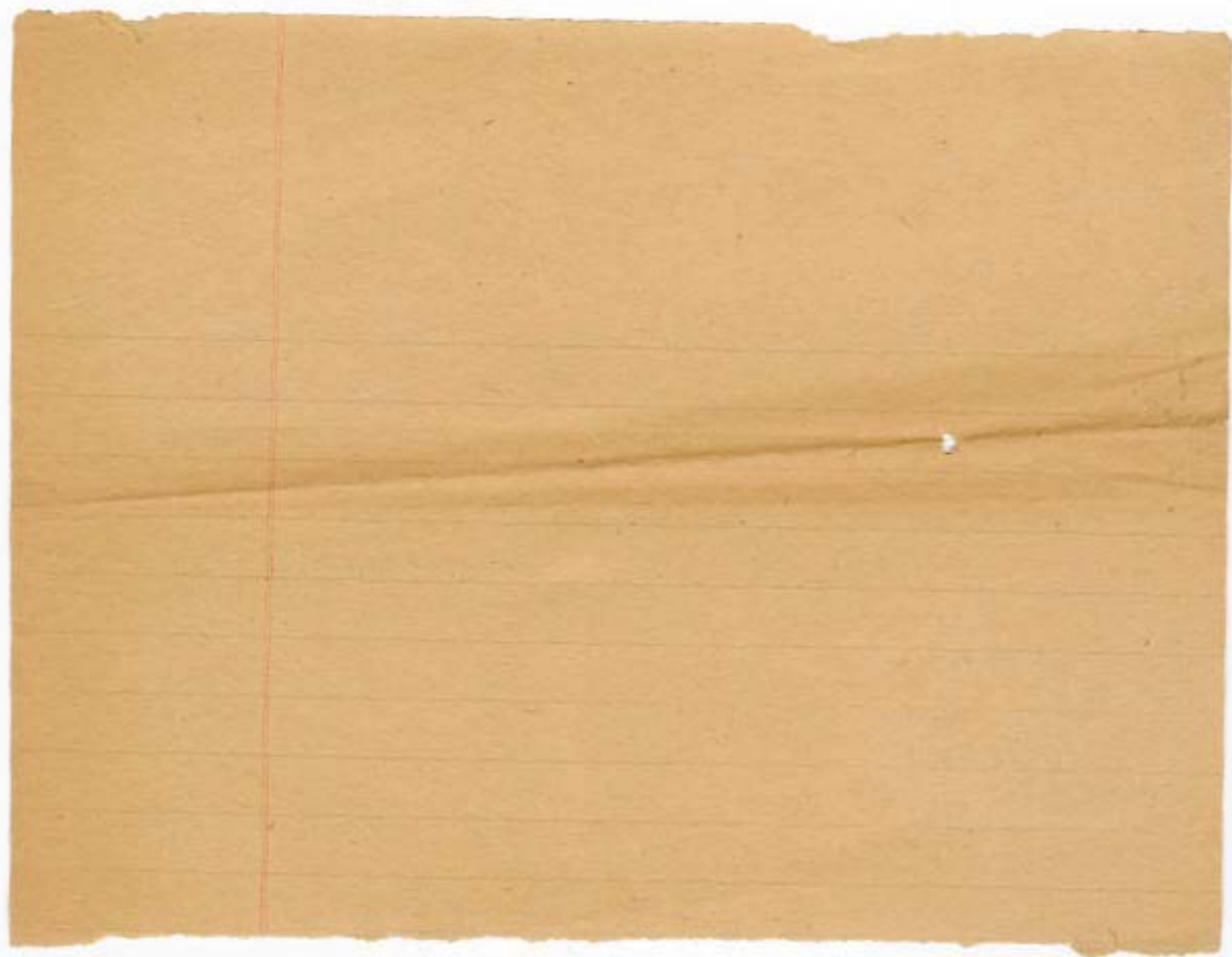

And be it remembered that on the 30th day of May, 1911, W. H. Purry was brought before me, O. B. Roller, Mayor of the Town of Harrisonburg, and ex officio, Justice of the Peace of said Rockingham County, charged with a misdemeanor in this, that he did assault and beat one James H. Gray, a warrant for the same being expressly waived, and is by me upon the oaths of James H. Gray and Maggie Ettinger, found guilty of said offence wherefore, I judge that he pay a fine of \$5.00 and \$4.00 costs, and that he be confined in the jail of Rockingham County, for the term of thirty days, but the said W. H. Purry having prayed an appeal from said judgment and tendered Mrs. L. A. Purry as his surety, who together with the said W. H. Purry entered into recognizance in the penalty of \$300.00 to be conditioned upon the appearance of the said W. H. Purry before the said Circuit Court upon the first day of its next term to prosecute said appeal, and the appeal is hereby granted him, to the next term of the circuit court of Rockingham County, and the said judgment and conviction as well as said appeal is hereby certified to the said Court.
