Commonwealth of Virginia, Rockingham County, to wit:

Be it remembered that on this 24th day of February 1912, Claude L. Armstrong and L.S. Armstrong came before me John P. Burke, Mayor of the town of Harrisonburg, and severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in manner and form following: That said Claude L. Armstrong and the said L.S. Armstrong each in the sum of \$1.50 and \$1.50 to be respectively made and levied of their several body and chattel lands tenements, to the use of the Commonwealth of Virginia, if the said Claude L. Armstrong shall make default in the performance of the condition underwritten.

The said Claude L. Armstrong and L.S. Armstrong hereby waive the benefit of their exemption as to this obligation.

The condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above bound Claude L. Armstrong do and shall personally appear before the Circuit Court of Rockingham County on the first day of the next term thereof, then and there to answer the Commonwealth for and concerning a certain misdemeanor by him committed, to wit: an assault and battery upon one L.D. Yow wherewith the said Claude L. Armstrong was convicted before me and from my said judgment has taken an appeal to said court and shall not depart thence without leave of the said court, then the above recognizance shall be void, else to remain in full force and virtue.
