ROCKINGHAM COUNTY, } TO WIT:


To the sheriff, a Constable of said County:

Whereas, Geo. M. Shreve of the said County, has this day made complaint and information on oath before me, D. H. Earman a Justice of the said County, that T. L. Harrison of the said County, on the 4th day of November 1915, in the said County, did unlawfully and feloniously cause to be taken by Marian Shreve a drug with the intent to produce abortion

These are therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me, or some other Justice of the said County, the body of the said T. L. Harrison to answer the said complaint and to be further dealt with according to law. And you are required to summon

to appear and give evidence in behalf of the Commonwealth, on the examination touching the said offence.
