Be it remembered that on this 13th day of September, 1919, V. T. Rankin and J. Holmes Moore, of said City, personally came before me, J. C. Staples, a Justice of the said City, and severally acknowledged themselves to owe to the Commonwealth of Virginia, the said V. T. Rankin the sum of One Hundred and Fifty ( \$150.00) Dollars, and the said J. Holmes Moore the sum of One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars, of their respective goods and chattels, lands, and tenements, to be levied, and for the use of the Commonwealth rendered.

Yet upon this condition, that if the said V. T. Rankin shall, for the term of twelve months, from the date hereof pay to Chief-of-Police F. L. Dovel to be paid to Mrs. V. T. Rankin the sum of Twelve Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$12.50) on each and every consecutive Monday for fifty-two (52) weeks) and beginning on Monday, September 15, 1919.

Then this recognizance shall be void, otherwise, to remain in full force and virtue.

Barkin the sum of One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars, and the said J. Holmes Moore the sum of One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars, of their respective goods and chattels, lands, and tenements, to be levied, and for the use of the Commonwealth rendered.

Yet upon this condition, that if the said V. T. Barkin shall, for the term of twelve months, from the date hereof pay to Chief-of-Police E. L. Dovel to be paid to Mrs. V. T. Barkin the sum of Twelve Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$12.50) on each and every consecutive Monday for Fifty-two (52) weeks) and beginning on Monday, September 16, 1918.

That this recognition shall be valid, obligatory, and enforceable in full force and virtue.
