COUNTY OF ROCKINGHAM, TO-WIT:

In the Circuit Court of said County:

The jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in and for the body of the County of Rockingham, and now attending the Circuit Court of said county, at its August term 1919, UPON THEIR OATHS PRESENT, that, James Turner, Raymond Hoover and Dalany Hoover on the 11th day of November 1918, in said County, maliciously and unlawfully but not feloniously take and carry away, destroy, injure and deface the property of one Perry Hoover, by shooting a gate off of its hinges and otherwise destroying other property of the said Perry Hoover, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of Perry M. Hoover and Mrs. Perry M. Hoover.
