COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA,

COUNTY OF ROCKINGHAM, to-wit:

In the Circuit Court of said County:

The Jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in and for the body of the County of Rockingham, and now attending said Court at its October term, 1922, upon their oaths, do present that Charles E. Campbell within one year next prior to the finding of this indictment, and continuously during said year, in the said County of Rockingham, did unlawfully, without just cause, wilfully neglect and refuse to provide for his wife, Lonia Campbell, and his seven children, Flossie May Campbell, fourteen years of age, Jessie Virginia Campbell, twelve years of age, Joseph Leonard Campbell, ten years of age, Goldie Campbell, eight years of age, Roxie Campbell, six years of age, Medford Campbell, four years of age, and Hubert Campbell, two years of age, they being in destitute and necessitous circumstances, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of Lonia Campbell and Billie Mike Mertz, witnesses sworn in Court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.
