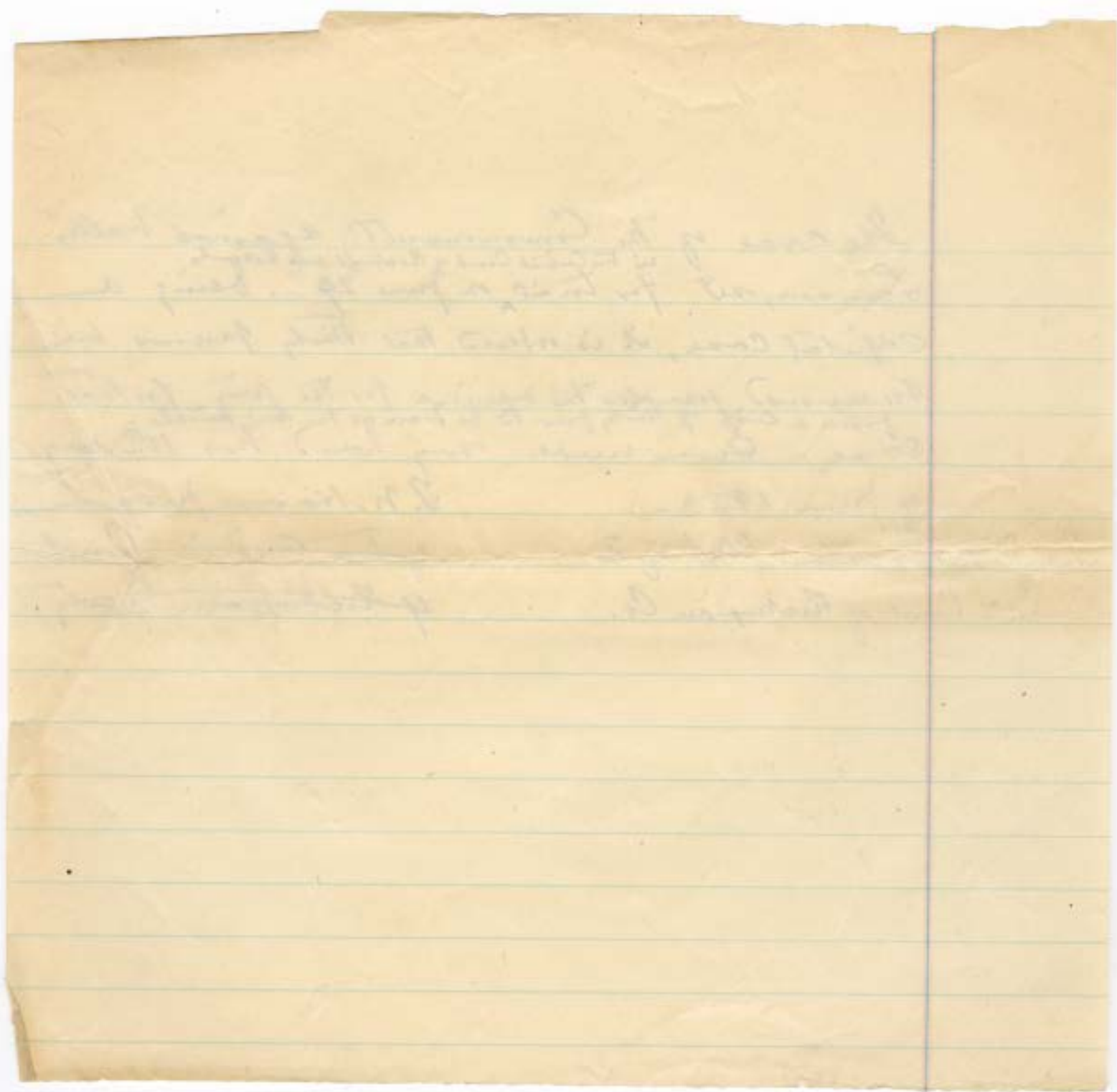


The case of The Commonwealth against Walter
