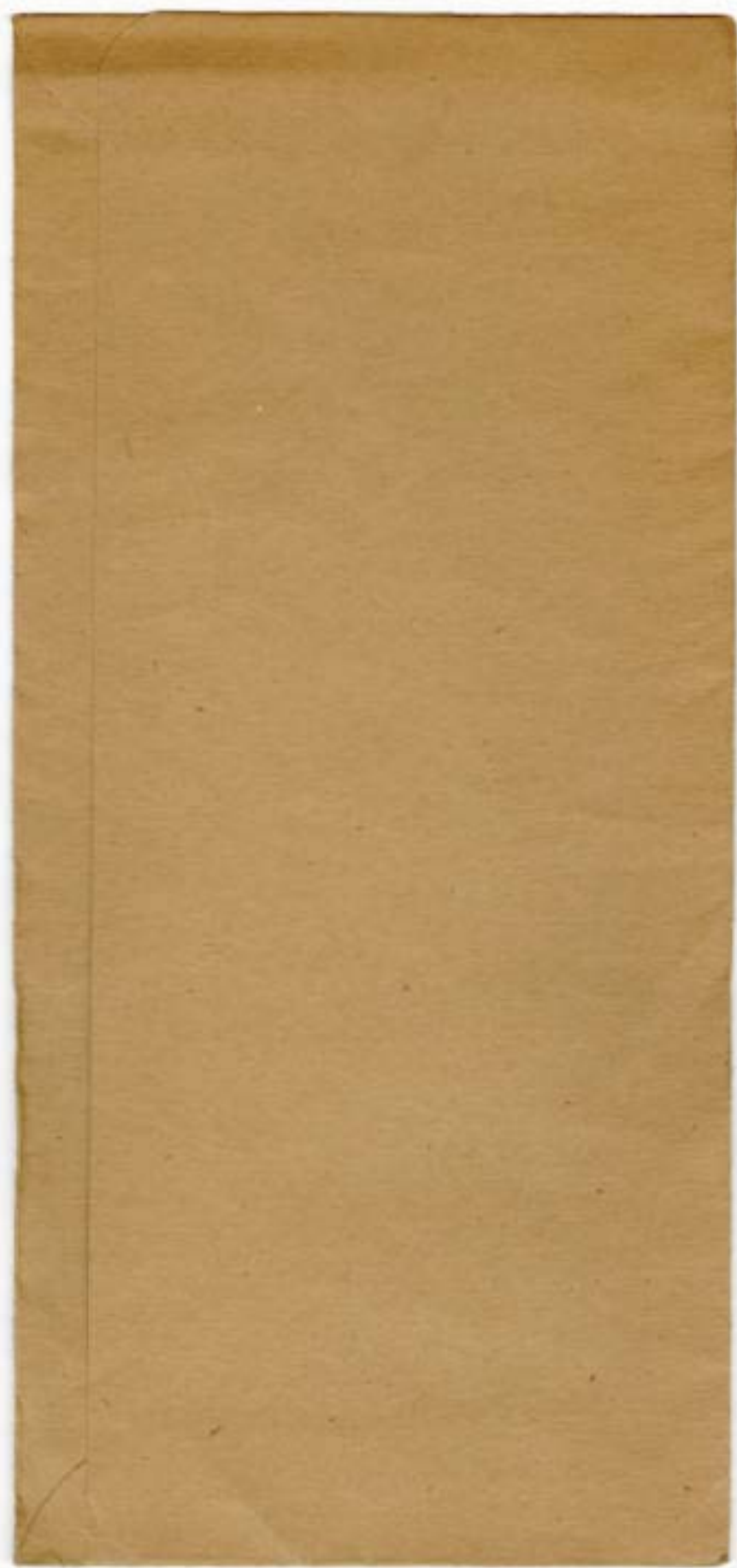

COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA,

COUNTY OF ROCKINGHAM, to-wit:

In the Circuit Court of said County:

The grand jurors in and for the body of said County of Rockingham and now attending said Court at its April term, 1924, upon their oaths do present that Arthur D. McLearn on or about the 15th day of March, 1924, in the County aforesaid, while a prisoner of the Virginia State Penitentiary, having been convicted for a felony, house-breaking, on Monday, February 4th, 1924, in the Circuit Court for the County of Prince William, and sentenced to confinement for a period of one year in said Penitentiary, and while in the custody of Sergeant L.S. Reames and while being guarded by one Tracy Wisner, in the County of Rockingham, did unlawfully and feloniously escape from said officers when a member of State Convict Road Force, Camp Number 32, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of L.S. Reames ✓ and J. O. McGaffin ✓ witnesses sworn in court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.

This indictment is found upon testimony of the grand jury of the County of Middlesex, Massachusetts, sitting at the Court House in Boston, Massachusetts, on the 19th day of May, 1944, against the defendant, Arthur D. McLearn, a fugitive from justice, who is charged with the crime of being a fugitive from justice, in violation of the provisions of Chapter 270B, Section 1, of the Acts of the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to-wit: that the defendant, Arthur D. McLearn, did unlawfully flee from justice, and did unlawfully conceal himself from the authorities of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, with intent to avoid arrest and prosecution for the crime of being a fugitive from justice, in violation of the provisions of Chapter 270B, Section 1, of the Acts of the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
