

COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA.

COUNTY OF ROCKINGHAM, to-wit:

In the Circuit Court of said County:

The grand jurars in and for the body of said County of Mockingham and now attending said court at its April term, 1924, upon their caths do present that Arthur D.MoLearn on or about the 15th day of March, 1924, in the County aforesaid, while a prisoner of the Virginia State Penitentiary, having been convicted for a felony, house-breaking, on Monday, February 4th, 1924, in the Circuit Court for the County of Prince William, and sentenced to confinement for a period of one year in said Penitentiary, and while in the custody of Rergeant L.S. Reames and while being guarded by one Tracy Hisner, in the County of Rockingham, did unlawfully and feloniously escape from said officers when a member of State Convict Road Force, Camp Number 52, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of L.S. Reames and J. O. McGuffin, witnesses sworn in court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.
