



ROCKINGHAM COUNTY, to-wit:

In the Circuit Court of said County:

The jurors of the Commonwealth in and for the body of the county of Rockingham and now attending said Court at its February term, 1926, upon their oaths do present that Charlie Hensley, William Statten, and J. E. Sellers, on or about the 6th day of February, 1926, in the county of Rockingham, did unlawfully and knowingly sell to George Wyant, a case of diseased, corrupted and unwholesome eggs, *Said eggs being intended for human consumption*, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of John Hawkins, George Wyant, J.W.E. Warble, and R. M. Burke, witnesses sworn in Court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.

Collecting the same herein to said Wyant,
