

COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA,

COUNTY OF ROCKINGHAM, to-wit:

In the Circuit Court of said County:

The jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in and for the body of the county of Rockingham, and now attending said court at its October term, 1926, upon their oaths present that Theodore Toliver on or about October 5, 1926, in said county, in the city of Harrisonburg, on North Mason Street, between Wolf and Rock, did run into, over and collide with one Alex Huggard with an automobile, thereby injuring the said Alex Huggard, and thereafter failed to stop such automobile and return to the place of the accident and render such aid and assistance to the said Alex Huggard as was necessary or possible under the circumstances, and failed to give his name and address to the person so injured, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of John Logan, Pat Tams, Sam Templeton, Alex Huggard, and Phoebe Harper, witnesses sworn in court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.
