The jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in and for the body of the county aforesaid, and now attending said Court at its August term, 1928, upon their oaths present that Lloyd Dove on or about June 6, 1928, in the said county, in and upon one Alex Grove, feloniously made an assault, and him, the said Alex Grove, did then and there feloniously put in bodily fear and danger of his life, and one hundred fourteen dollars cash, the property of the said Alex Grove, from the person and against the will of the said Alex Grove, then and there, feloniously and violently did steal, take and carry away, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

In the Circuit Court of said County:

The jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in and for the body of the county of Rockingham, and now attending the said Court at its August term, 1928, upon their oaths present that Lloyd Dove, on or about the 6th day of June, 1928, in the night of that day, feloniously and burglariously did break and enter the dwelling-house of one Alex Grove, situated in the said county, with intent the goods and chattels of him, the said Alex Grove, in the said dwelling-house, then and there being, then and there feloniously and burglariously to steal, take, and carry away, and one hundred fourteen dollars in cash of the goods and chattels of the said Alex Grove, in the said dwelling-house, in the county aforesaid, then and there being found, then and there feloniously and burglariously did steal, take, and carry away, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

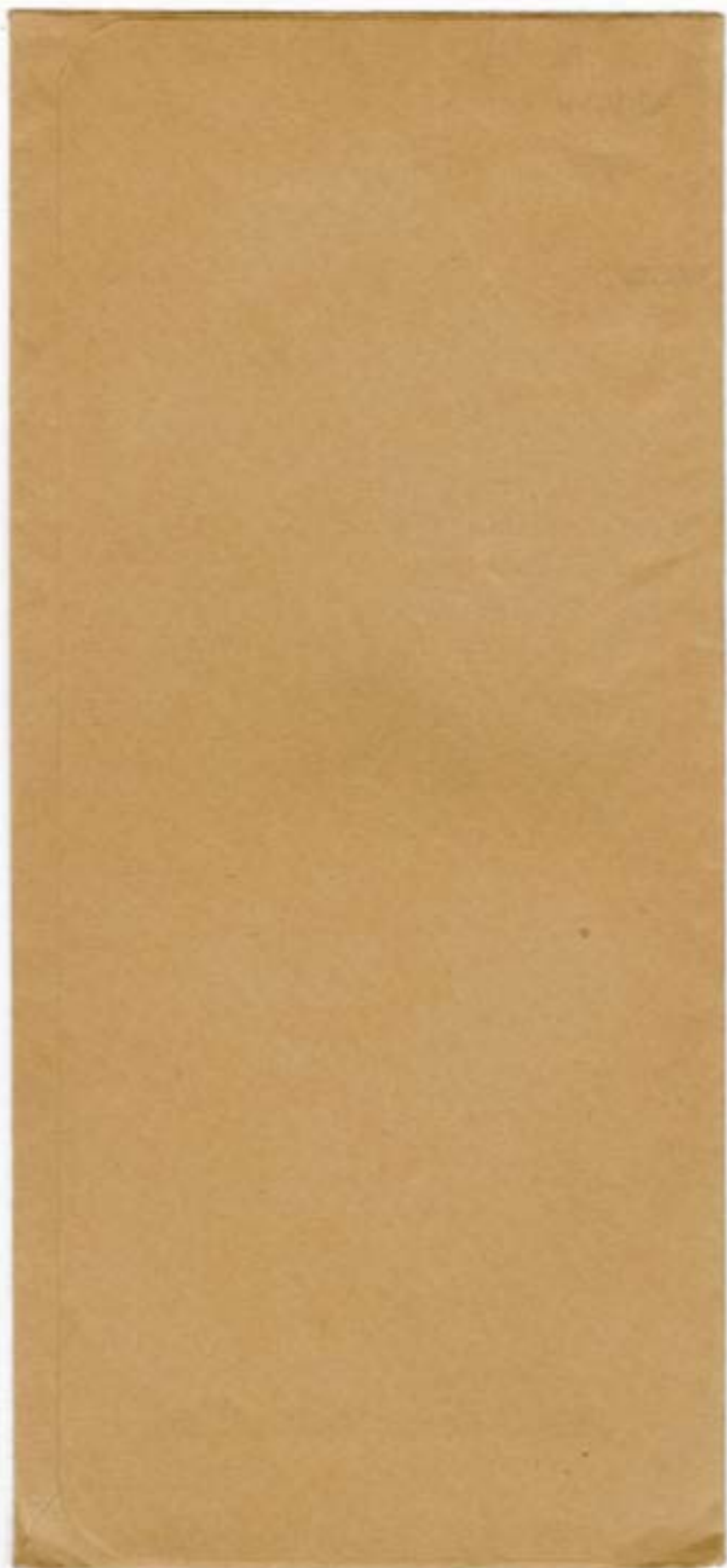
